Important: angle your loudspeaker only a little bit to the middle. Clean electric is important. For this take my high end music electric cable and my big power line conditioner - converter. Now you are not only on the way to just some kind of sound but to musical truth. Your body and your heart will feel it.

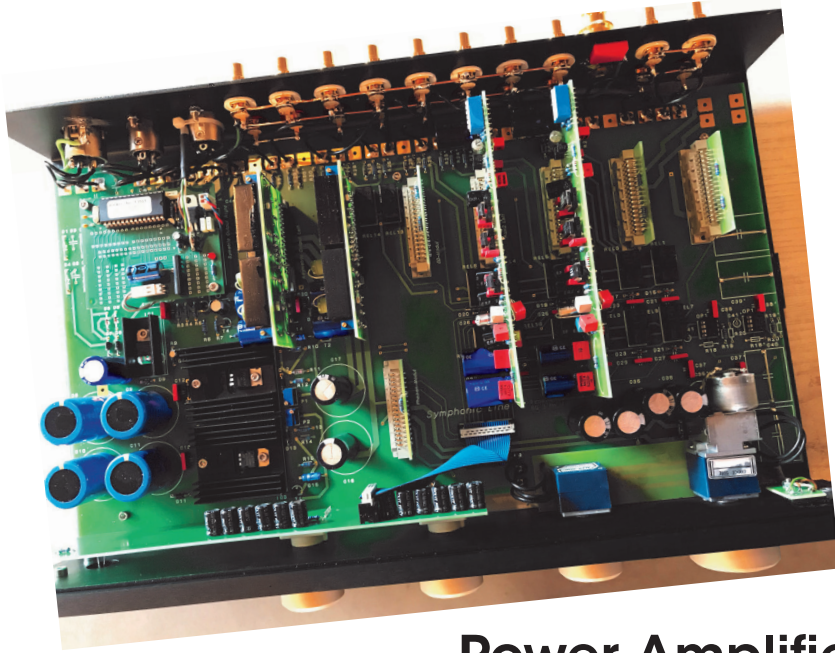

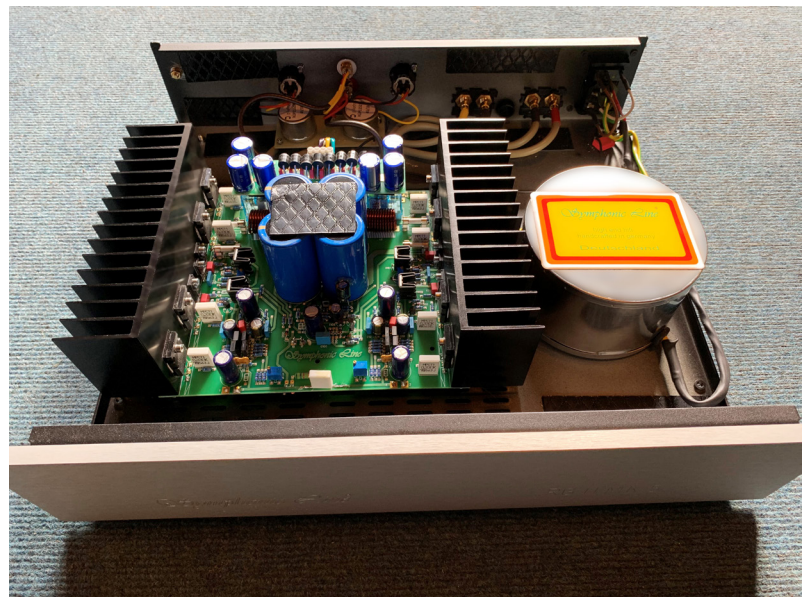

Symphonic Line presents the fifth version of its famous RG 3 preamp – and equips the modularly expandable Class A preamp with the most powerful power supply in the portfolio for maximum performance. In the test, the classic RG 3 MK 5 Reference Edition demonstrates how the skilful combination of clarity and power leads to pure music.

Classic – this title of honour is achieved through high quality and a long-standing reputation spanning far and wide. The RG 3 is a prime example of this: Symphonic Line has been making this preamplifier for almost 35 years – and it enjoys an almost legendary reputation for its classy sound. That's why Rolf Gemein, high-end pioneer and founder of Symphonic Line, doesn't need to conjure up a new device every few years. Instead, he favours continuity: The RG 3 and all other components – lovingly handcrafted in the Duisburg factory – must be durable and upgradeable. For decades, the Duisburg-based manufacturer has been offering a select number of amplifier models that are constantly being further developed – and as such they can be updated and optimised through various expansion stages. All of this also applies to RG 3: Having now reached the MK 5 generation, the preamp can be flexibly configured thanks to its modular design. It can also be upgraded using different versions of the external power supply unit.



The serial number is immortalised underneath – as well as the assurance that this preamplifier is a handcrafted one-off from our own factory.



Extensive range of connections: The RG 3 offers four line inputs. The two aux inputs can alternatively be realised as phono connections. The ground terminal then serves as a ground contact for the turntable(s) to prevent ground loops. There are also two tape loops for connecting analogue recording devices. All cinch sockets are top models from WBT.



The RG 3 has a modular design. This means that the preamplifier can always be brought up to date and can also be configured in different ways or upgraded at a later date. For this purpose, Symphonic Line offers a balanced input or output or the equipment with one or two phono modules – optionally for MM or MC turntables. Motorisation of the volume potentiometer for remote control of the volume is standard.



The external power supply unit enables the RG 3 to be upgraded: Symphonic Line offers various power supply versions that differ in terms of performance and quality. Our test model of the RG 3 is equipped with the Reference Edition shown here – the most powerful and highest quality power supply unit. External power supply unit for silence and power.

However, the basis of good sound is always a generously dimensioned, reserve-rich power supply. For this reason alone, the power supply unit of the preamplifier has been relocated for reasons of space. This separation also makes it possible to upgrade the RG 3: Symphonic Line offers four different power supply units that differ in terms of dimensioning and quality. Our RG 3 is equipped with the largest power supply, the Reference Edition turbo power supply unit. Our test model also owes the second part of its name to this. This power supply unit – weighing just under 20 kilos – contains two high-power 300 volt ampere mumetal toroidal transformers and a rectifier

whose filtering and smoothing capacitors have an impressive total capacity amounting to a whopping 320,000 microfarads in a cascade configuration. This power supply unit is therefore highly deliverable and could also supply two power amplifiers. This is the basis for a quiet and powerful performance of the amplifier. In favour of the sound quality, the components are of the very highest manufacturing and quality standard. The transformers are expensive mu-metal versions with multiple annealed cores. This improves the magnetic properties, increases efficiency and reduces core losses.



The Reference Edition power supply unit is equipped with two powerful, 300 volt-ampere MuMetal toroidal transformers. The filter and smoothing capacitor section is just as large, with a total capacity of 320,000 microfarads. This powerful and reserve-rich power supply is the basis for a quiet, superior amplifier performance – and could actually supply two power amplifiers with its power.



Experiment:

In the test, we combined the world-class electronics with a first-class 7,000 euro sound transducer to hear what happens – with astonishing results.

Feeling of authenticity

This suddenness already tells us a lot about the superb dynamic ability of the RG 3. It turns the skilful drumming of the sought-after session drummer Keith Carlock into a percussive feast. The bass drum has a wonderfully precise punch, the pressure of each kick gently massages our stomachs. This feeling of authenticity is also created by the rich snare that Carlock hits to introduce the actual song after the slow intro. In between, he plays continuous eighth notes on the hi-hat: Here, too, we're amazed at how smoothly and accurately these strokes can be experienced – including the extremely fine gradations of velocity: We hear every touch of the wooden stick with the metal cymbal. The RG 3 really shows us the materiality of the drums. This also applies to the toms and snare, where we can hear the touch of the head, the defined rattling of the snare carpet, the vibration and resonance of the drum shells. This is exactly how a drum set sounds and works in reality!

Acoustically invisible

Thanks to the excellent dynamics and directness, we first notice this natural liveliness in the drums. However, the freshness actually characterises the entire rendition. The RG 3 delivers coherent timing for impulse fidelity. This can be seen first and foremost in the interplay between drums and bass. Carlock and Washington demonstrate their world class – and it's a pleasure to listen to this rhythm section: Bass tones and bass drum beats are perfectly aligned, yet beats and tones are clearly and distinctly perceptible as two sound events. Nothing blurs, the RG 3 also shines here with precision and accuracy. The drum patterns and bass figures are perfectly harmonised, the timing of this team is fantastic – and that's exactly what the RG 3 reproduces. Perhaps it would be better to say: It conveys everything just as it is. In fact, this preamp doesn't even make an appearance; on the contrary, it does the best that an audio component can do: It makes itself acoustically invisible. Three-dimensional visualisation Baker's chord progressions are another delicacy: We've never heard such clear harmonically flavoured multiphonics with several tone extensions! That's why we have to grin now: because we can hear what cheeky dissonances Baker smuggles in here – partly anticipating the vocal melody and partly playing a kind of answer to this vocal line. This results in a musical complement, a whole that we're only now realising. The acoustic excellence of the amplifier therefore enables a deeper understanding of the music. This doubles the pleasure. The spatial imaging also contributes to this: The three-dimensional visualisation power of the RG 3 is simply breathtaking. It creates a wonderfully spacious stage that also extends far into the depths. The musicians have all the freedom they need to develop to their full potential. This marvellous freedom also has a double effect: On the one hand, we perceive the musical events as incredibly open, unlimited and airy; on the other hand, this perception enhances relaxation when listening to music.



The RG 3 offers two outputs for the power amplifier connection. This enables bi-amping operation with two power amplifiers. The two XLR sockets can optionally be assigned as an additional balanced input or output. The connection for the external power supply unit is positioned on the far right.

Intensity and emotionality

In front of the Staatskapelle Dresden, Anna Netrebko as Mimì and Rolando Villazón as Rodolfo fervently confess their love for each other – and this duet makes us revel because we are so close to the two star singers: We hear every delicate vocal inflection, every breath, and experience the couple directly with all their intensity and emotionality. When

they sing "Fremon già nell'anima" together – their voices shining together for the first time in marvellous harmony – we involuntarily close our eyes and get goose bumps because this music is beautiful to sink into. Thanks to the perfect acoustic reproduction, we can see in our mind's eye how the soprano and tenor turn towards each other as they sing, how they sing not just next to each other but with each other – and finally depart together, as their duet "Amor! Amor! Amor!" breezes to us from afar. A great final effect to a magnificent rendition.



The straight lines of the amplifier's design are matched by the curves of the engraved Symphonic Line logo. Underneath, the number and the assurance "Single handcrafted in Germany" bear witness to the fact that each amplifier is unique and handcrafted.

Conclusion

Symphonic Line's RG 3 preamplifier is now in its fifth generation and in its maximum

expansion stage – delivering world-class performance as the RG 3 MK 5 Reference Edition. The modular expandable and upgradeable preamp achieves this thanks to the cleanest amplification in pure Class A operation and a power supply with the Reference Edition, the largest of the various selectable external power supplies. This combination of clarity and power leads to pure music: The playback is free of any compression effects. It shines with outstanding naturalness, coherence and harmony. Thanks also to the superb dynamics, it has such a directness that the preamp itself virtually disappears and presents the musicians and their instruments alone with breathtaking realism. This is also due in part to the immense physicality of the reproduction and the superb spatiality of the overall presentation. All this is also possible with the optional excellent phonomodule for vinyl playback. The RG 3 MK 5 Reference Edition – made for world-class power amplifiers – delivers pure acoustic excellence.

True hi-fi enthusiasts therefore prefer, for the best possible sound, separate, externally housed power units - so-called power amplifiers. One of the world's finest power amplifiers comes from the small, refined hi-fi manufactory Symphonic Line.



Company founder and sonic "mastermind" Rolf Gemein of Symphonic Line has, for more than four decades, devoted himself with heart and soul exclusively to sound - critical aspects.

The brand Symphonic Line originates in the heart of Duisburg and, over the past decades, has earned an outstanding reputation through its exceptionally high-quality, hand-crafted amplifiers and CD players. Almost a hidden gem, if one does not consciously follow the mainstream of hi-fi components. Behind the conception, the design, and the acoustic mastery of Symphonic Line stands its founder Rolf Gemein, who, with unimaginable meticulousness and dedication, has made the achievement of the world's finest sound his life's calling.

In Duisburg, with love for music, with heart and soul, and with musical sensitivity, the RG7 MKS power amplifier is manufactured. An important principle of Rolf Gemein is that the manufactory in Duisburg is guided by the conviction that all products are designed to provide their owners with first class music enjoyment for a lifetime. No device leaves the

manufactory without having been personally checked and refined down to the smallest detail. Even small circuit modifications are implemented only after intensive listening tests. Customers can speak directly with the manufacturer at any time - for every question and for every detail of fine adjustment.

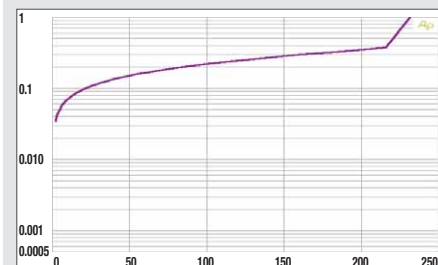
Our review sample RG 7 MK 5 is the main model within the extensive twochannel power amplifier range and has for many years held the reputation of a reference-class amplifier. This particular test device corresponds to the latest MK 5 version, which is also available in the variant RG 7 MK 5 Reference Edition.

In this version, selected components are further optimized. The RG 7 MK 5 Reference Edition delivers a maximum output of 135 watts and was provided exclusively for evaluation in our listening room.

RG 7 MKS Reference Edition fact at 25 kilograms in weight, this solid amplifier brings serious mass to the scale and, with its size and volume, appears both solid, powerful, and imposing. From the outside, the RG 7 MK 5 Reference Edition impresses through its massive front panel and gigantic heat sinks.

Every single component of the RG 7 is meticulously examined for its sonic character, consciously selected and assembled in careful handcraft.

TEST INFORMATION



Performance

A solid 224 watts per channel distinguishes the RG7 MK 5 Reference Edition in our laboratory from many competitors. That is sufficient for unlimited dynamic potential and lends impulsive musical signals enormous vitality.

Particularly remarkable are the massive solid-metal rings surrounding the large toroidal transformers, suppressing highly specific resonances. Massive side panels form the foundation of the power amplifier stage.

The largest portion of weight, however, is carried by the dual-mono power supply inside. Here, two ring core transformers of generous dimensioning provide sufficient current for both of the class A/B output stages. Both transformers are mounted separately in their own rings made of massive metal, which effectively suppress vibration transmission via the housing. We deliberately chose this detail after years of listening sessions. In this regard, we agree entirely with the manufacturer's statement that sound, too, can be "compressed and stored" in the smallest structures and even in long cables - and subsequently released again. In fact, Rolf Gemei subjects every single component extensive listening tests. Every transistor, every capacitor, every resistor - each must first be "blessed," so to speak, before it is permitted to enter the Reference Edition.

In our Reference Edition, Rolf Gemei has already included gigantic capacitors of 320,000 µF for the power supply. Buffer capacitors are further increased. This enables an even faster, cleaner current delivery to the power transistors. Resistors of various types are also tested and selected from numerous high-grade examples. The same applies to the switchable input for symmetrical signals. Even costly input transformers are part of the standard equipment in the exquisite Reference Edition.

Laboratory and Practical Performance

An appropriately dimensioned heat sink and the massive cooling body ensure optimal operating temperature and therefore maximum performance. All laboratory measurements of the MKS Reference Edition move within an extremely tight tolerance range. Even a signal-to-noise ratio of 91 dB (A), above average for 88 dB (A), and almost imperceptible distortion of 0.006% speak a clear language. The question of true output power is answered emphatically: Our laboratory determined a full 224 watts per channel

- more than sufficient for loudspeakers with virtually limitless dynamic mic capacity.

As a playing partner for a well-appointed high-end loudspeaker system, this full amplifier of the RG 7 requires nothing further. Its preamplifier section also proved to be outstanding in the listening test. It delivers musical substance with deep black backgrounds and a fine, harmonious flow across all frequency ranges.

Nothing is exaggerated, nothing understated. Balanced in presentation, sovereign in its authority, the large power amplifier plays with enormous power reserves and almost musical effortlessness. Its sheer musical performance invites unrestricted pleasure in listening. 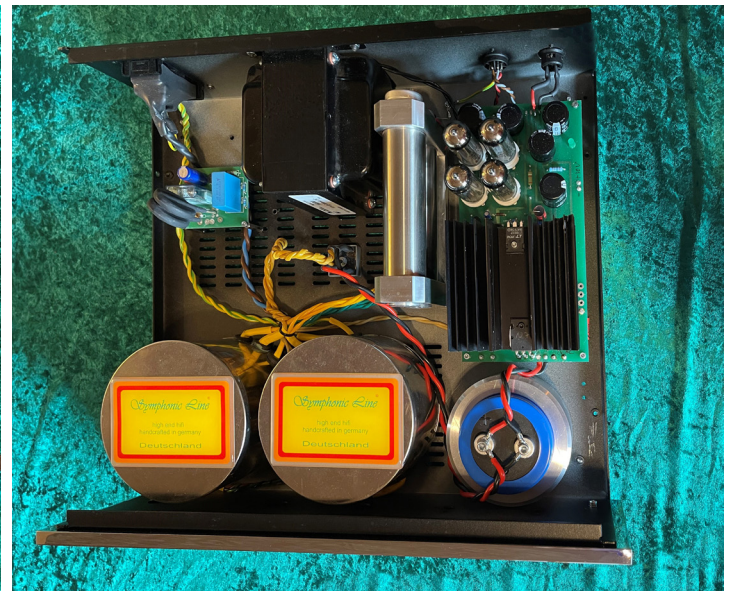

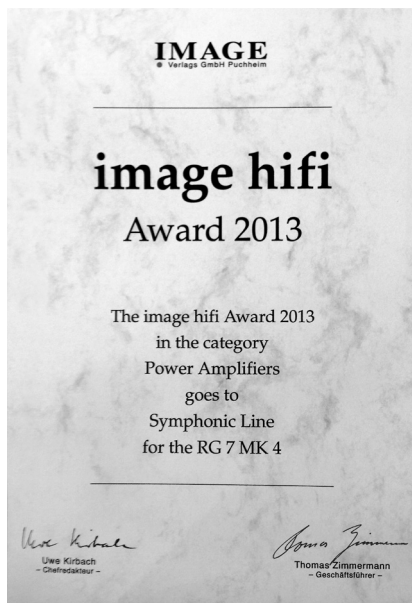

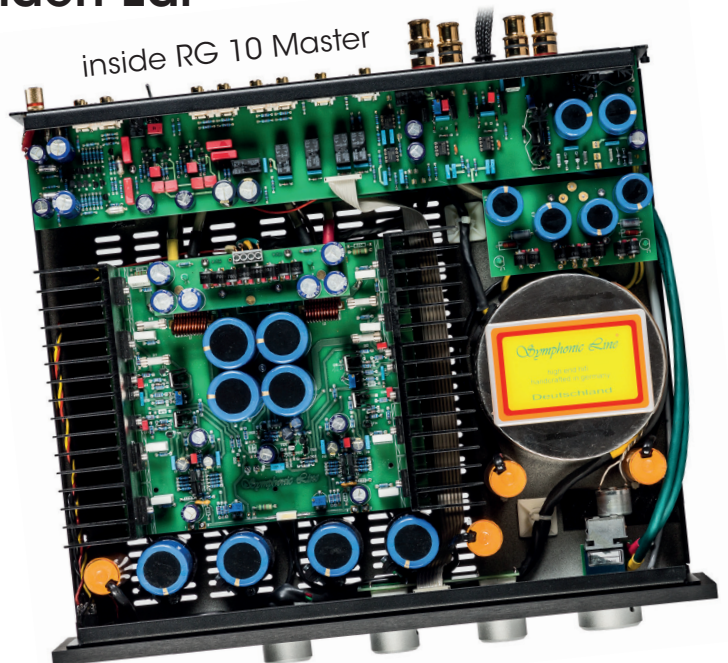

The Still Point

In more than 40 years of my engagement with music reproduction, I have never before held a component by Rolf Gemein in my hands. It was high time.

We live in strange times, more so than ever before. Yet what I seek in these days is a haven of calm - and it is music. Music lives and breathes authenticity, and it needs devices that are capable of conveying precisely that. Rarely have I felt such an urgency to find this fine sensitivity. Whoever possesses this delicacy must also

be able to find it. This refined sensibility is not new to Rolf Gemein, founder and creative force behind Symphonic Line. In between, there were whispers of a certain tranquility emanating from his devices. In an era when almost everything seems able to touch us only superficially, to invite music in and allow it to remain - that is rare.

Finest Sensitivity My first conversation with Rolf Gemein was a special one. Rarely have I encountered a hi-fi manufacturer who possesses such an immediate connection - perhaps born of a mutual openness. And an extraordinary sensitivity and perceptive ability form the foundation of his work. Added to this is a deep bond with music and with his instruments, which always stand in the service of music reproduction. From the very first notes of the RG 14 Edition MKS S, it was clear to me how this man sees and understands his devices. For he connects these components directly with the music - and makes you forget their reproduction.

The Man and the Company About Symphonic Line and Rolf Gemein, virtually everything has already been written - one might almost think there is nothing left to say. Perhaps this is precisely what makes this company so exceptional.

It began in childhood. Inspired by his grandfather, who was a piano and vocal instructor, Rolf discovered the world of tones. Like a natural born searcher, he sought pure sound. These harmonic vibrations touched and shaped his entire being. Years later, together with two friends in a Dusseldorf ice cream cafe, he decided to establish the best amplifier in the world. This was the begin of the Company "Vernissage". So the tinkering began - equipped with his gift for learning components and their characteristics empirically, gathering immense experience over time.

Yet three individuals proved too different in the long run to carry forward the shared vision. From the foundations laid during those early experiments, Rolf Gemein created Symphonic Line.

Hi-Fi components can, in principle, be designed in two ways: technically circuit-driven or tuned through voicing. Rarely do both approaches come together. Certain circuit concepts had

already been commissioned decades ago. Otherwise, the engineer works with ideas he develops himself. Ultimately, everything is crafted in his own workshop - like Jonathan Carr, for example, who develops and tunes his Lyra tonearms himself, though he does not physically build them.

Everything You Need

The Symphonic Line range is broad and can appear confusing. Yet if one immerses oneself deeply enough, one quickly recognizes light in the seeming darkness. Rolf Gemein does not build to fill a gap in the market. He builds what he considers necessary. And if a manufacturer tells him that the budget is insufficient, then

Short signal paths are standard at Symphonic Line. Have you noticed the cable in the background? That, too, has been evaluated for its sonic impact.

One might buy a used component and lovingly bring it up to the latest standard. But where does one still find something like that? Rolf Gemein has been doing exactly this since the early 1980s, because the mere idea of discarding well-made things runs contrary to his nature. It also matters deeply to him that as much as possible comes from Germany: the capacitors, for example, are a custom production from Northern Germany. For Rolf Gemein, the availability of good sound - which he rightly regards as a form of healing - is a true calling, never a marketing construct. The RG 14 Edition MKS S therefore possesses qualities that are rarely found at this price level - if at all. And truth be told, one does not really need more than this integrated amplifier to listen to music in deep contentment. But let that remain between us.

Much More Than Technology

Around ten years ago, I once confessed to former T +A chief developer Lothar Wiemann that his devices had once left me emo ~ ally untouched, whereas something had changed in the meantime. He laughed and said that earlier they had only measured - now they listened more.

With Rolf Gemein, the situation is almost the reverse: electronically, his devices are beyond reproach, but never obsessively demonstrative. They become exceptional through his Individual Resonance Pattern Alignment (RMA). One might compare it to the fine-tuning of a Formula 1 car, individually set up for a specific driver. In a similar way, Gemein employs, for example, a special gel beneath his signature labels that absorbs unwanted resonances - of which there are many within any device - while generating positive vibrational behavior. For his tuning to achieve true coherence, Gemein primarily considers three categories: energy, phase

and perception. Particularly crucial is the ability to deliver high energy in extremely short time spans - across all frequency ranges simultaneously. For this reason, he uses exceptionally potent power supplies. In our review unit, a newly developed transformer encapsulated in mu-metal is at work. Ultimately, the precise details of what he does and where he does it are secondary. He knows why he does it - and we can hear the result. One further note: the C37 lacquer, which Gemein applies at selected critical points, was developed by Austrian violin maker Dieter Ennemoser. The resonant behavior of this lacquer corresponds to the density of human bone - hence the designation C37. Its application may therefore be understood as a bridge to human perception. Gemein uses it to damp sensitive components so that they retain their specific resonance characteristics for as long as possible. All Symphonic Line circuits operate in pure Class A for approximately the first watt, only transitioning into Class AB at higher output levels. The design also reflects the size of the employed heat sinks. Fundamentally, however, the topology ultimately follows the logic of Class B. The circuit boards are made of 2 mm epoxy, copper-plated up to 130 micrometers and generously gold-plated at sonically critical points. Gemein's effort is substantial - and costly - but his devices are typically extremely durable and sonically of the highest caliber. With an outstanding phono input offering both MM and MC capability, as well an exceptionally fine headphone amplifier, the RG 14 Edition MK 5 S has everything what a true music lover needs - without digital gimmickry.

The Sound

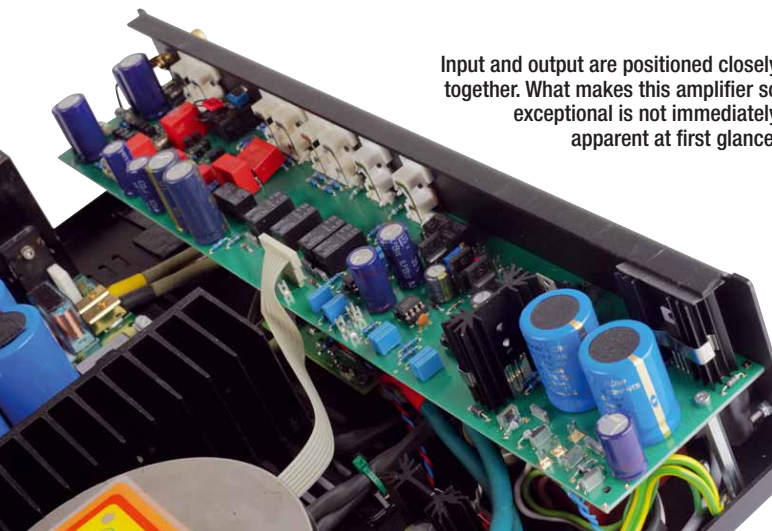
It is worth listening to a Symphonic Line component at least once without prejudice. With its in-house developed power supply - and even the cables, crafted within the company itself - it creates a sound that feels almost otherworldly and yet profoundly natural, capable of carrying both micro- and macrodynamics with the utmost transparency and ease into the listening space.

Marcus Miller's debut album radiates brilliance and refinement without ever turning harsh. "Lady" by Beck, Roger, Appe & Friends shimmers with clarity and authentic presence. Particularly captivating is Claudio Abbado's recording of the Four Seasons with Gideon Kremer and the London Symphony Orchestra. Here, the amplifier reveals not only delicacy but also authority, dynamic power and a rich spectrum of tonal colors. Nothing pushes itself forward, yet every detail, every swift impulse, every spark is present and alive. And then Giammarina Testa tells me of her life in her live album "Solo dal vivo": direct, unfiltered, immediate. One only has to close one's eyes - and understand. Later it becomes clear: it is the feeling that we are hearing something truly special - live - and in doing so reconnecting with the kitchen of our childhood. The Symphonic Line RG 14 Edition MK 5 S is like a beloved companion whose existence we somehow always sensed, yet never fully knew.

Conclusion

The Symphonic Line RG 14 Edition MK 5 S is nothing less than the very essence of musical reproduction - and thus one of the finest integrated amplifiers under the sun.

Input and output are positioned closely together. What makes this amplifier so exceptional is not immediately apparent at first glance.

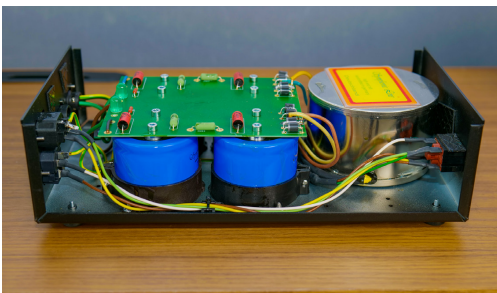

No frills, excellent core: the legendary RG 10 also has a noble design in the MK 5 Reference HD Master S version - now Symphonic Line has bundled forty years of high-end development into this compact integrated amplifier. This results in a world-class amp for analogue music enjoyment, including an MM/MC phono module. In the test, we experienced the perfection of this full-feature set.

Sustainability! Rolf Gemein has nothing but a smile for the supposed novelty of the responsible use of resources. The high-end pioneer and founder of Symphonic Line has been building the finest audio components - and especially the finest amplifiers - according to this maxim for more than forty years. They all follow Gemein's philosophy of quality and continuity: the handcrafted components must be durable, updatable and upgradeable. For decades, the Duisburg-based manufacturer produced amplifier models in select numbers and constantly developed them further. Even after many years of use, you can upgrade them to maximum expansion level. This also applies to the RG 10: this transistor integrated amplifier, which, like its little brother RG 14 already tested by us, has cult status in hi-fi audiences, is now in its fifth generation - and comes to the editorial office fully equipped as an opulent RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S.

Subtle design with characteristic quality

The physicality of this maximised amplifier is as impressive as the model name: it weighs a massive 17 kilos - despite the moderate dimensions of 106 by 450 by 420 millimetres. Classic styling and a discreet design add to the compact dimensions. Nevertheless, the RG 10 is immediately recognisable as a Symphonic Line component. The front features an artistic engraving of the curved company lettering - followed by straight-line milling of the model name and the function designations of the controls. These engravings seem extremely discreet because the one-centimetre-thick front is realised in finely brushed and anodised aluminium. Alternatively, you can order a front panel in black. A chrome-plated version is also available for an additional charge. The appearance of our amplifier continues in an exceptionally harmonious way with the satin-finished metal knobs. They come with a distinctive bevelling and an engraved dot, providing orientation concerning the current setting.



A look into the master module shows its material-intensive qualities: A second, referred to as a "super transformer", is at work here. On the right, you can see the encapsulated special transformer. The separate power supply provides an additional capacity of 280,000 microfarads. This significantly increases the entire current delivery capacity. Also, it allows for a sonically advantageous independent power supply of the pre and the power amplifier.

tended to eliminate unwanted resonances, vibrations and disturbances and to promote a natural sound. Gemein describes this final tuning as "resonance pattern tuning"; the high-end pioneer carries it out by ear alone until the amplifier plays harmoniously in his sense, offers the full spectrum of timbres and achieves the musicality typical of Symphonic Line.

The Symphonic Line RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S in the field

Let us finally take the RG 10 into our listening room. First, we put the Oppo UDP-203 SACD player at the amplifier's side, and two Audio Physic Midex act as speakers. After connecting the amplifier, we allow the RG 10 time to settle for a more coherent performance. We kick off with Donald Fagen's "Security Joan". Beforehand, however, we set the amplifier to the lowest volume - and after a few seconds, we are amazed: despite the low level, the music delivers an outstanding presence and effortlessly floods the room! We are particularly astonished by the bass: it already boasts volume and low frequency and provides a rich foundation. We take a seat on the sofa and are amazed for the second time: already at this low volume, the RG 10 performs harmoniously, putting numerous musicians on a roomy stage on which every instrument can be perceived - and we are talking about 14 musicians here!

Musical merit in perfection

Frontman Fagen has gathered a background choir, three guitars, an organ, piano, bass, percussion and drums behind him for a clever mix of rock, funk and jazz. The music is complex, the instrumental set interwoven and dense. Yet every single vocal and instrument is traceable, clearly locatable on the imaginary podium and perfectly staggered, even down to the drums positioned in the back. We have not heard that before - wow! With a grin on our faces and looking forward to listening to it louder later, we let the RG 10 warm-up - it now delivers all the musical excellence we already enjoyed in perfection. We only have to crank the amplifier up to a third of its volume to reach the most saturated level. The bass comes with immense energy. We feel every touch and every low note of Freddy Washington's five-string all over our bodies. What power!



The super transformer is recognisable through the ventilation slits in the amplifier bonnet. It provides the "S" in the model name - and acoustically causes an increased power and sound culture compared to the standard transformer. The applied yellow pad indicates the "resonance pattern tuning" that Symphonic Line boss Rolf Gemein performs himself on each amplifier.



The RG 10 is a true powerhouse: If you turn it up almost halfway, as in this case, you will already enjoy an opulent volume. If you prefer to use it as a headphone amplifier, you will not encounter any sound problems, even with models suffering from low efficiency.

Outstanding dynamics, intoxicating freshness

In addition, percussionist Keith Carlock drives straight to the guts with a snare, toms and bass drum. The drum set packs an opulent punch while remaining tidy and crisp. This shows off even the finest intensity gradations that the gifted drummer masterfully incorporates into his patterns. The RG 10 achieves all this with outstanding dynamics and an intoxicating freshness - and so we notice after a few seconds how we involuntarily bob along to the irresistible groove of the music. Here, the RG 10's high and fast current delivery capability and ample reserves pay off. It also leads to an effortless and self-evident reproduction: Despite the powerful drum work, we hear the refined, silvery ride cymbal, which Carlock plays consistently but gently. It asserts itself effortlessly despite its unobtrusiveness. Through the dense sound fabric, we can even perceive how this cymbal tone changes as it decays. This is also enabled by the RG 10's excellent openness and transparency.

Revelation in self-evidence and harmony

Our setup remains suboptimal: We placed the external power supply unit along with the other components of the sound chain on the sideboard. We now follow two recommendations by Rolf Gemein. Firstly, it is advisable to place the master module on the floor. We do this - and are astonished for the third time: The reproduction becomes noticeably more stringent and more defined, especially in the bass. Secondly: Place the power supply unit on its narrow side. We do this as well - and are impressed for the fourth time: the dynamics increase again in excellence. Drums and percussion show even more agility. Singers and instruments seem even livelier. We perceive every stroke of the strings of the overdrive guitars. RG 10 also wins again in terms of openness and airiness. In addition, there is an even stronger serenity and calm. We have already sunk into the sofa and enjoyed listening to music with the utmost relaxation. Now, however, the naturalness and harmony are a revelation.



Symphonic Line supplies a simple plastic system remote control to adjust the volume from a distance.

Overwhelming live authenticity

In addition, this amplifier reflects even the subtlest changes highly sensitively. So any cable change is noticeable: First, we swap our high-quality signal cables for the Symphonic Line Reference, then our high-class loudspeaker cable for the Symphonic Line Harmonie HD - and in both

cases, we obtain yet another benefit in terms of resolution, dynamics and coherence. Likewise, the plasticity and three-dimensionality of the imaging are even more impressive with each tuning step. That makes the live recording of the Brindisi from Verdi's opera "La Traviata" a delight: we listen to the opening orchestra, but also the whispering and laughter of the audience in the hall - and thus experience, even feel the atmosphere of the Munich National Theatre. Things are lively on stage, too: In the background, the chorus, who appears here at a festive party, clink glasses and toast each other. In front of them, Anja Harteros as Violetta and Piotr Beczala as Alfredo are charming each other - and this banter has an overwhelming live authenticity.

Imagination running wild

Harteros and Beczala vividly occupy the stage during their charming duet and audibly move around the podium. All this is perfectly captured in the recording and is rendered flawlessly by the RG 10: The soloists make us revel with their gifted singing and, especially in the case of Anja Harteros, with an utterly beguiling voice. The festive company floods the stage in the tutti passages with concentrated choral power. The excellent Bavarian State Orchestra, audible right down to the bowing of the violinists, provides the instrumental accompaniment. With our eyes closed, we spend a glamorous evening at the opera, sitting in the middle of the theatre. The immersive illusion also occurs through headphones: We connected our Focal Utopia to the RG 10 - and our imagination is running wild at its best: now the nuances, particularly the clinking of glasses by the musicians and the lively action of the soloists, including the sound of their steps on stage, appear even more intense.



The back of the external power supply unit: The mains plug on the bottom right provides the connection to the mains socket, while the socket above it feeds the power amplifier. The four-pin socket on the left provides the necessary juice for the preamplifier.

Clarity, purity and perfection

Here we hear another quality we already experienced and tested in loudspeaker operation: The RG 10 amplifies incredibly noise-free. This also contributes to the clarity, purity and perfection of the sound. How does the RG 10 perform in vinyl playback? We hooked up our Transrotor Dark Star turntable. It is equipped with the MM system Uccello which samples "Ordinary Guy", the opening song of the current LP "Let the Hard Times Come" by Jacob Dinesen. The Danish singer and guitarist, audibly inspired by Bruce Springsteen and Allan Taylor, delivers a beautiful intimate singer/songwriter ballad with "Ordinary Guy". Dinesen opens the piece with a plucked Western guitar. It is perfectly recorded and equally perfectly reproduced by the RG 10: We witness the gorgeous brilliance of the steel strings, which Dinesen audibly plucks with his bare fingers, which is why the sound also has a beautiful warmth, and we also able to notice the resonating wood of the guitar body.

Conclusion

The Symphonic Line RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S represents the maximum expansion stage of the RG 10 with Reference preamplifier module, external auxiliary power supply and additional refinements. In this ultimate version, the legendary amp represents an unspectacular sensation: the no-frills, purely analogue integrated amplifier delivers music reproduction with delightful purity, outstanding resolution and impressive richness of detail, as well as excellent dynamics in both coarse and fine detail. The imaging possesses an almost immersive three-dimensionality and plasticity. In addition, the amp shines with tremendous power as the basis for a marvellous calmness and composure. The RG 10 bundles all this into a reproduction with absolute coherence and perfect harmony. Listening to music becomes a thrilling and moving experience - and so the Symphonic Line RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S emerges to be a world-class amp.

Vinyl playback via MM is to die for ...

Now Dinesen enters with his calm, slightly rough and yet melodious voice, which is amazingly reminiscent of Springsteen. This singing gives us goosebumps: Dinesen feels very close to us, and we hear every little breath, every rubbing of his vocal cords, every turn he takes vocally, sometimes towards the throaty, sometimes towards the smoky, always intense but never intrusive. The intimacy catches us even more because the sound remains clear of artefacts. There is no sampling noise or crackling, which other amplifiers sometimes emphasise strongly. As a result, pure music sounds like a matter of course and makes you forget all technology. It is to die for. Soon Dinesen receives company from Jens Pilgaard on bass and Jesper Andersen on percussion. The bass plays discreetly but provides a soothing foundation. The percussion consists primarily of a snare played with a broom - but here, too, you can listen to the individual metal wires hitting the drumhead.

... and even more catchy via MC

Could it possibly get any better? Now, we equip our record player with the Goldring Ethos MC system, play "Ordinary Guy" again - and promptly receive the answer. Dinesen's voice now sounds even more articulate and insistent, the guitar has more wire and wood, the percussion acts more agile, and the bass acquires more contour. In addition to Dinesen's vocals and the instruments, we also understand the subtle reverb embedding in the voice, the guitar, the bass and the snare. As a result, the imaging appears even more impressive in its spatiality: in our perception, it replaces the listening room surrounding us in its existence. Finally, the beautiful background vocals unfold entirely: Together with Dinesen's solo voice, they establish a pleasantly melancholic polyphony. This choir warms our hearts. This music touches us. We imperceptibly hold our breath so as not to spoil this precious moment. You can't ask for more from a musical reproduction.

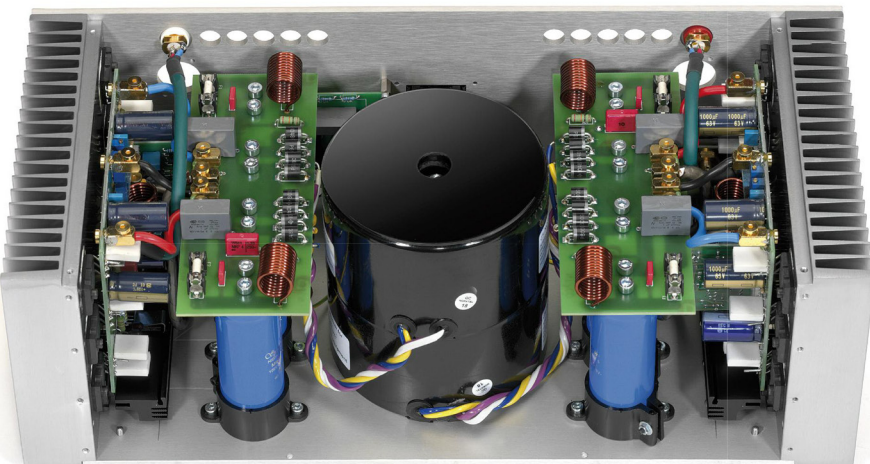

Galactically Good

“The Turntable” is what Symphonic Line calls its high-end record player, the RG 6 Reference - and it lives up to this claim of absoluteness with ease: With perfect precision and sophisticated design, maximum mass and an elaborate drive system, this belt-driven turntable, in combination with a top-class tonearm and a premium cartridge, enables fantastic vinyl reproduction.

Symphonic Line - when this name is mentioned, audiophiles' eyes light up and they usually think of superb signal amplifiers. And rightly so: The excellent reputation of the Duisburg-based manufacturer is founded first and foremost on world-class integrated amplifiers such as the Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference Edition, the RG 14 Edition MK 5 S, the RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S, the preamplifier RG 3 MK 5 Reference Edition or the power amplifier Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3, which Rolf Gemein, founder and mastermind of Symphonic Line, has been continuously building for decades, repeatedly updating and retrofitting for his customers - keyword: sustainability. On the other hand, the audio specialist's portfolio also includes the finest loudspeakers and CD

players such as the CD-Player Reference MK 3 as well as equally excellent components for vinyl playback - such as the RG 6 Reference. Deep down, Rolf Gemein is a vinyl enthusiast.

Massive Precision Instrument

This becomes clear to anyone who visits the co-initiator of the German High End show in his Duisburg manufactory and enters the listening room: In this room, where Gemein personally performs the final fine-tuning of every Symphonic Line audio component, there is a lavish and superbly stocked LP shelf covering the entire wall, housing over 3,000 records - and the no less impressive RG 6 Reference. This turntable, which Gemein has been building and continuously refining for 40 years, is his premium source and therefore operates permanently: The analog drive runs around the clock every day - and has done so for years. The RG 6 Reference is a massive precision instrument - and there are two reasons why it is practically immovable and why we traveled to Duisburg for this test: The total weight of this turntable is a hefty 50 kilograms, with several additional pounds added by the supplied granite base and the powerful power supply.



The platter is normally covered with the supplied special cowhide mat. Without the mat, one can see the fastening of the 21-kilogram platter to the sub-platter-like bearing sleeve. Here it is connected by only two screws. The bearing is so sensitive that any additional screw would entail sonic changes. The upper separate part of the spindle is removable. Thanks to this division, the energetic connection to the bearing remains interrupted even after insertion.

Massive Solidity and Mechanical Sensitivity

In addition, the drive unit - and especially the bearing - is manufactured so precisely and with such minimal tolerances that even temperature fluctuations influence its performance. Likewise, the multi-part RG 6 Reference rewards careful assembly and setup with a break-in period. This combination of massive solidity and mechanical sensitivity forms the basis for the turntable's acoustic accuracy and finesse.

Let us first address the weighty aspect: The RG 6 Reference is a mass-loaded turntable - and is made entirely of aluminum. All components of the multi-part analog drive are milled from solid material. The nearly five-centimeter-high and 40-centimeter-diameter chassis alone weighs about twelve kilograms, plus the tonearm mounting platform. The exceptional design of this turntable begins with the oval shape of the chassis. Gemein chose this visually appealing and flowing geometry for acoustic reasons as well, to minimize vibrations as effectively as possible. Residual resonances are neutralized by bitumen pads applied to the underside.

Defined Vibration Dissipation for Clear Sound

This chassis rests on three spikes. They enable point-contact coupling to the surface beneath: This is the supplied marble slab, whose high weight and resistance to vibration also contribute to mechanical and acoustic calm. Two spikes are positioned in the narrower area of the tonearm mounting platform. They are height-adjustable and allow perfect horizontal alignment of the RG 6 Reference. The third spike is actually a foot. It is located in the wider section of the chassis, centrally beneath the platter and the bearing - at the point where the entire weight of the drive is concentrated. Here, the foot serves to dissipate vibrational energy. This energy originates from the move-

ment of the stylus, from the resulting vibration of the record, and from the rotation of the platter and spindle in the bearing. Without dissipation, this vibrational energy would remain in the drive, feed back into the pickup process and degrade the sound. Defined dissipation, on the other hand, enables the fundamental tone and bass capability that many turntables lack.

Imposing Base, Impressive Platter

On the top side, the chassis houses a substantial mounting platform for the tonearm. This base is also milled from solid metal, rises eight centimeters high and measures 15 centimeters in diameter. Once again, considerable mass counteracts potential vibrations - in this case those originating from the tonearm. Despite its weight, the mounting platform appears to float: It is largely decoupled from the chassis and has only a single point of contact. This makes the platform rotatable. Thus, a wide variety of tonearms up to twelve inches can be mounted on this base - flexibly, quickly and easily. It is both a clever and elegant solution. The larger counterpart to the round, rosette-like mounting platform is the platter: Again milled and turned from solid aluminum, this mighty, millstone-like, eleven-centimeter-high platter weighs an impressive 21 kilograms. Once more: plenty of mass for maximum calm. After all, the greatest movement occurs in and on the platter due to its continuous rotation.

The Bearing: Perfect Precision, Low-Friction Rotation

The bearing is responsible for the smoothness of this rotation. Here, too, massiveness prevails: The bearing itself weighs one and a half kilograms. To prevent energy transfer to the chassis, the bearing is mechanically decoupled from it. The quality of the bearing distinguishes our Reference version from the standard RG 6: The precision and minimal tolerances with which the 16-millimeter spindle made of special stainless steel runs in its sleeve are achieved through elaborate manual polishing with diamond powder. This precision ensures highly low-friction, wobble-free, consistently even and smooth rotation of the spindle. Lubrication with a special oil of particular viscosity also contributes to this. The bearing base, on which the convex-ground spindle rotates with minimal point contact, promotes wear- and friction-minimized rotation thanks to its immense hardness: It is made of sintered tungsten carbide-cobalt hard metal Widia. All this enables such precision that temperature fluctuations indeed influence rotation.



Here the tonearm platform is configured for the Linn Ekos SE. The nine-inch tonearm is the flagship of the Scottish high-end manufacturer.



The externally housed powerful motor drives the platter via a long belt. The associated control unit guarantees and monitors highly precise and constant rotation. The speed - optionally 33 1/3, 45 or 78 rpm - is set via two multi-turn potentiometers and can be adjusted with utmost precision. The third rotary knob switches the motor on and off.

Accurate Drive, Elaborate Control

his deviation is compensated for via the external control unit of the separately housed motor. Both assemblies continue the circular design language in favor of harmonious aesthetics, yet they are nestled together to form a horizontal "8." The necessary connecting cables run invisibly through their small contact area. The origin of the high-quality and powerful precision motor is a closely guarded company secret of Symphonic Line, as is the exact functioning of the control unit. Its uniqueness can be guessed from the fact that two so-called multi-turn potentiometers serve the same purpose: the precise adjustment of the rotational speeds 33 1/3, 45 and 78 rpm. These precision resistors can rotate several turns, operate ultra-finely and across a wide range, which is why they are also first choice for audio applications. This allows ultra-precise fine adjustment of the motor speed. The drive sets the platter in motion via a long belt. Gemein chooses belts from Transrotor because they are manufactured without a transition at the joint and therefore run particularly evenly.

Planetary Ensemble with Passive Secondary Drive

For even more low-friction rotation, the Reference version of the RG 6 features an additional second drive unit. It closely resembles the motor but is passive. This second drive unit is placed directly opposite the motor, so that the platter sits between them. This symmetrical arrangement guides the belt tangentially along the platter. This relieves the spindle, as it is no longer subjected to one-sided tensile forces. As a result, friction and resonances in the bearing are further reduced. Sonically, this dual drive is said to enhance the calmness and spatiality of reproduction. With this second drive, the RG 6 Reference consists of five elements. Due to their shape and positioning, they resemble a planetary ensemble. This association fits perfectly because - to anticipate it - the RG 6 Reference sounds galactically good. But this is also due to the power supply and the harmonious combination with an excellent tonearm and superb cartridge.

High-Powered Power Supply

Let us begin with the power supply: As befits this league, it is also external and housed in the typical robust, black-painted sheet steel enclosure from Symphonic Line. The dimensions of 10 by 37 by 19 centimeters and its considerable weight already suggest what lies inside: a highly potent power supply. Under the hood is a transformer rated at a generous 350 volt-amperes and a filtering and storage section whose capacitors provide an impressive capacity of 140,000 microfarads. In Gemein's own words: One could build an amplifier from this. A powerful power supply ensures a high degree of stability thanks to its large and prompt delivery capability and abundant reserves, thereby contributing to the calmness of the drive. There is even room for improvement here: Instead of the "Power supply," the RG 6 Reference can be equipped with the "Turbo power supply": It operates with two Super-Mu metal transformers, each delivering 300 volt-amperes, and a capacitor combination with a capacity of 300,000 microfarads.



In the Reference version, the RG 6 is equipped with a second passive drive unit. It is positioned opposite the motor so that the platter is located precisely between them. This avoids one-sided tensile force on the spindle - and thus minimizes friction in the bearing.



The front of the external power supply. It is housed in the typical robust Symphonic Line enclosure. Thanks to its powerful transformer and the substantial capacity of the filtering and smoothing capacitors, the power supply guarantees high delivery capability and ample reserves. This promotes rotational smoothness and stability of the drive - and thus the composed performance of the turntable.

Top-Class Tonearm and Noble MC System

Now to the arm and cartridge: Neither is included with the RG 6 Reference. Gemein has equipped his model with the noble Linn Ekos SE, this nine-inch arm, but fitted it with his own headshell cable. Beneath the headshell sits the Symphonic Line RG 8 Gold MK 3. Gemein has this MC system manufactured by A.J. van den Hul according to his own specifications and with materials that are no longer available on the open market today. He considers him the world's greatest authority in the field of cartridge construction. The coil wires of this system are finer than a human hair and made of pure gold. To increase the output voltage, the system features an additional front-mounted magnet, delivering 0.4 millivolts. Other voltage values can be realized upon request. Naturally, the scanning gemstone features the vdH 1 Van den Hul cut. Thus, the MC system scores with channel separation of over 40 decibels and a frequency response extending beyond 60,000 Hz.



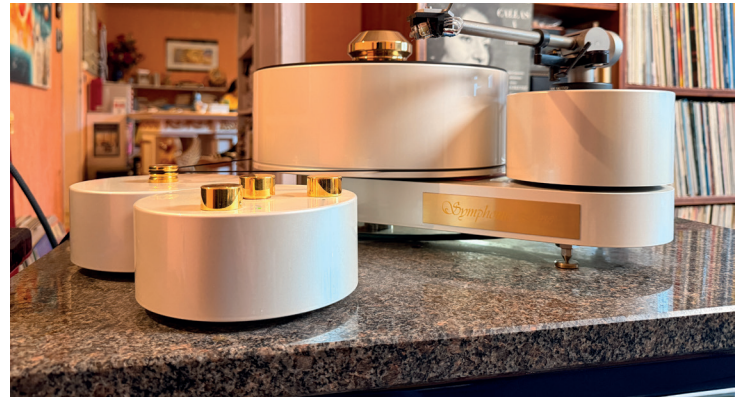
Beneath the headshell sits the RG 8 Gold MK 3, a new version of Symphonic Line's excellent MC system. It enables superb tracking of the record with extremely low groove noise. Manufacturing is handled, according to precise specifications, by the Dutch specialist van den Hul. The system's coils are wound with ultra-fine gold wire. The additional magnet is mounted at the front. It increases the output voltage - and also allows a stylus to adhere here, making azimuth adjustment easier during setup. Upon request, the cartridge is available in a wooden version.

Final Fine-Tuning

Of course, Gemein also performs final fine-tuning on his turntable purely by ear to eliminate unwanted residual vibrations and disturbances and to achieve an absolutely harmonious sound. In addition to the already mentioned bitumen pads, we see one of Symphonic Line's special adhesive pads between the top of the chassis and the platter, and another applied to the transformer of the power supply. Rolf Gemein also applies C37 lacquer at selected points, with which he has also coated the tonearm. The MC system supplied by van den Hul is likewise fine-tuned once again by Gemein. Tuned in this way, the RG 6 Reference now stands before us ready to play. Gemein's model is painted in mother-of-pearl, which perfectly matches the gold-plated rotary knobs and record weight. The turntable can also be painted in any other desired RAL color. This finish is extremely expensive because it must be absolutely smooth and homogeneous. Especially on the rotating platter, any wave or streak would immediately be noticeable.



The shine of the tonearm results from fine-tuning: Rolf Gemein applies C37 lacquer during his personally conducted final sonic tuning of each component.



The entire drive rests on a granite slab, adding further mass for calm and relaxed reproduction. This granite slab is included in delivery and can be sized according to customer preference.

The Symphonic Line RG 6 Reference in Practice

In Gemein's listening room, the RG 6 Reference is connected via the Symphonic Line Reference NF phono cable to the integrated amplifier Symphonic Line RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S. A pair of Symphonic Line Belcanto Edition loudspeakers serve as transducers, which Gemein is currently optimizing and refers to as a test model. The sound chain is warmed up, though the cartridge has only logged a few hours of operation. In a few days and weeks, it will therefore sound even more open, freer and rounder. Even now, however, the reproduction is simply fantastic.

We experience this immediately at the outset with The King's Singers. The famous vocal ensemble performs the "Jimmy Brown Song" - and the very first entry is a revelation. The recording dates from 1976, yet the sextet possesses astonishing immediacy: The six singers seem literally to stand before us - grouped in a gentle arc around their central tenor Alastair Thompson.

Outstanding Presence, Superb Dynamics, Sonorous Foundation

Thompson opens with his crystal-clear voice the vocal story of Jimmy Brown. What immediately fascinates us is the directness: The physical presence of the tenor is outstanding. Soon his colleagues underpin his singing with magnificent harmonies - and with their entry intensify the illusion that the sextet is singing here in the listening room. This is also due to the superb dynamics: The singers masterfully grade their voices in volume and intensity, and these lively, vibrant changes are audible and perceptible even in the finest nuances. In such perfection, this vocal art produces goosebumps.

The illusion also succeeds thanks to the transparency and sonority of the reproduction. In the harmonies, we experience an absolutely differentiated blending of the six voices. We are particularly impressed by the reproduction of the baritones and the bass. Many analog drives show weakness here. With the RG 6 Reference, however, we experience a full fundamental and low-frequency range with room-filling foundation - especially during sustained drone tones in the bass.

Immersive Spatiality

We also enjoy the wonderful variety of melodies: The voices follow exciting lines in this choral arrangement, and we can effortlessly trace the intervals of each individual singer. As beautifully as the voices blend harmonically, all six vocal artists remain clearly distinguishable. This is also due to the excellent imaging accuracy. We can assign each vocalist a very precise position in space. Thus, song verses in which the action shifts back and forth between the countertenors and the baritone/bass section become a true stereo experience. The three-dimensional presentation also has impressive depth: The recording was made in the famous Abbey Road Studios, apparently in the huge Studio One, judging by the grand reverberation. The depiction of this spatiality is magnificent: Thanks to superb resolution, we even perceive the finest sound reflections from the studio walls. We can intensely and immersively experience the size of this hall; the imagined ambiance of the recording space makes us forget the real walls.

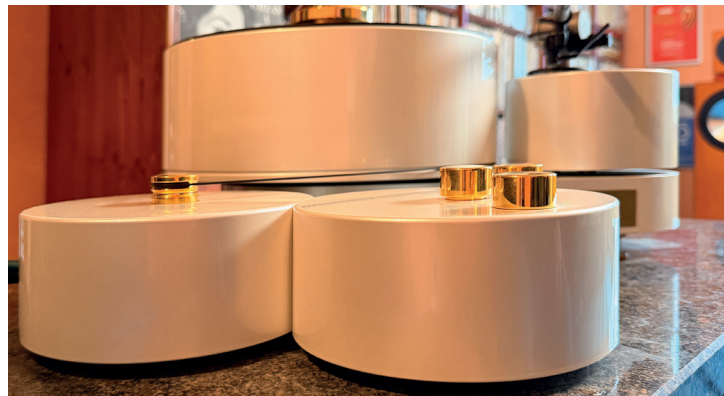
Purity and Calm

This works so well because, on the one hand, the record is tracked with extremely low noise. Here the MC system performs a true miracle with this aged LP. On the other hand, the reproduction shines with a wonderful and soothing calm: The singing of The King's Singers sounds absolutely natural, harmonious and completely relaxed, as if it could not be otherwise. Here the magnificent mass and immovability of the mass-loaded drive make themselves felt - along with the well-conceived dissipation of sound-blurring vibrations. Thus, the entire musical event unfolds against a deep-black background without distracting disturbances.

We experience this splendid purity and calm with other pieces from this session as well - for example with "Ordinary Guy" by Jacob Dinesen: The Danish singer-songwriter recalls Bruce Springsteen - and his singing now gives us our second goosebump moment. Dinesen's warm yet gently raspy voice sounds even more sonorous than we know it, even more intimate - and thus even more touching.

Phenomenal Power of Presentation

Dinesen accompanies himself on acoustic guitar. Thanks to the phenomenal power of presentation, the materiality now becomes tangible: We hear the steel of the strings, the wood of the resonating body - and, because of the soft tonal character of the picking, we know that Dinesen is plucking the strings with bare fingers. The bard is accompanied by bass and drums, and here too we realize: There is more in the record groove than we previously knew. The bass possesses noticeably more depth and carrying power while retaining the same contour definition. The drumming appears more agile: Jesper Andersen plays a shuffle on the snare with brushes, yet we have never before heard the impact of the bristles on the drumhead of the snare in such plasticity and with such dynamic gradation. The shuffle sounds wonderfully fresh! Even the background vocals, which we previously perceived more as a surface-filling layer, are now discernible in their individual voices. Thanks to this reproduction, "Ordinary Guy" climbs even higher on our list of favorite songs.

Pure Music

Let us switch to a richly instrumented track: "Mary Shut The Garden Door" by Donald Fagen. We know this song extremely well - yet now it sounds as if we had not put on the original LP but a more successful remaster. It begins already with the tracking: Our LP has many years and numerous plays behind it. Yet on the RG 6 Reference drive and with the RG 8 Gold MK 3 system, the record sounds almost new: It runs nearly free of any playback noise. We hear the pure music - and it astonishes us in every discipline.

The very opening with bass and drums arrives so abruptly that we flinch. For this, drummer Keith Carlock needs only a bass drum kick and a crash cymbal strike. Wow! After that, the drum kit remains wonderfully present: Every drum hit has a terrific attack thanks to the top-tier dynamics. The bass drum has a rich punch, the snare a delightfully dry crack.



Imposing weight: A gold-plated puck weighing around 800 grams presses the record onto the platter.

Unprecedented Wealth of Detail

We have never been able to hear the hi-hat figures so distinctly. They separate perfectly from the shaker, which otherwise slightly obscures the cymbal work. The superb transparency is also owed to the accurate bass. Here we marvel once again: We have never experienced Freddie Washington's striking low-frequency motif that shapes the song with such volume, power and thrust. At the same time, the deeply extended bass is extraordinarily clean. On this defined foundation, all other instruments can unfold freely.

And that is a good thing, because the song is arranged for eleven voices and instruments. In addition to bass and drums, there are percussion, guitars, keyboards, vibraphone, melodica, flute, background choir and lead vocals. Yet despite the large ensemble and dense arrangement, thanks to the excellent transparency we now clearly hear details that we had never previously noticed - for example, during the melodica solo, the tremolo guitar in the background that repeatedly throws in cool two-note figures with rapid alternate picking.

Truthfulness

Thanks to the clarity and the newly audible details, we understand the song better as well: The muted guitar patterns and tones thrown in from left and right now meaningfully complement the almost Morse code-like central keyboard motif. Here too we experience this remarkable coherence: The triangle, which otherwise often seemed somewhat intrusive, is now perfectly integrated; the background vocals are presented so clearly that in the wonderful tonal tensions of the melodic and harmonic progression we can hear every single interval leap. Phenomenal!

The crowning glory is finally the solo vocal: Fagen lisps slightly and has a hoarse, breathy, roughened voice. Often his voice therefore sounds somewhat strenuous, a bit amorphous and artificial. In this sound chain with the RG 6 Reference, we experience how the frontman truly should sound: Free from artificial sharpness, Fagen now has a truthful physical presence and stands before us as a real, corporeal person.

Conclusion

The RG 6 Reference fulfills its claim to absoluteness: "The Turntable" is what Symphonic Line calls its high-end record player - and it proves with flying colors that it rightly bears this title. As a mass-loaded drive, it ensures reproduction with wonderful calmness and composure, coherence and naturalness - as if it could not be otherwise. Contributing to this are the highly precise and elaborate bearing, the powerful motor with its passive second drive, and the potent high-performance power supply. In combination with a top-class tonearm and a superb cartridge, the RG 6 Reference achieves magnificent 3D imaging with virtually immersive spatiality and breathtakingly present and tangible rendering of voices and instruments. Thanks to its explosive dynamics, excellent resolving capability and outstanding wealth of detail, the musicians possess astonishing vitality and truthfulness. Through phenomenal purity, clarity and transparency, previously unheard details of the music are revealed. Thus, the performance of the planetarily designed RG 6 Reference is galactically good.

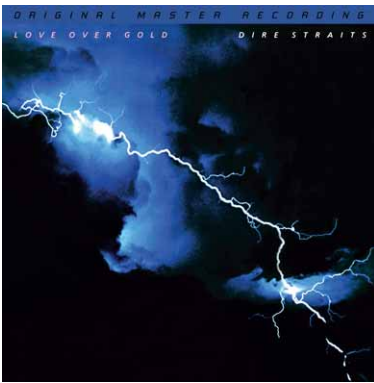

Because standstill would mean regression for the Duisburg pioneer, he once again refined his phono stage - already thoroughly matured in the current MK4 version - and endowed it with an even stronger dose of his distinctive sonic philosophy. Anyone who knows Rolf Gemein - and within the German hi-fi scene, everyone does - understands: here, marketing phrases are not fabricated. What matters is the vibrant tension between physical pragmatism and an almost fanatical search for musical truth. His trade-fair presentations are legendary (and amusing), his convictions as unwavering as the solid enclosures of his devices.

It is clear that precisely this stability also defines the Phonostage MK 4. No "chi-chi," no fashionable gimmickry, no superfluous gloss. It stands in the rack as if built for eternity. Symphonic Line does not chase trends. A standard was once set here - and it remains faithfully upheld.

Technically, Gemein adheres to his credo: everything that stands in the signal path must go. Whatever makes the signal "jump," whatever disturbs its flow, is removed with determination.

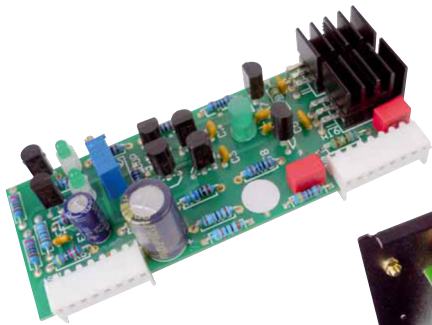
In the case of the Phonostage MK 4, the power supply and the big capacitors are deliberately oversized to an exceptional degree. Other manufacturers might power an entire integrated amplifier with that. In a Symphonic Line design,

the 300-VA toroidal transformer "merely" serves to stabilize the supply voltages. Small interjection: The power consumption of the Phonostage is modest - only around 26 watts - which makes it all the more generous. And that is the point: ample headroom is to be created - either through nothing but space, or through storage capacity. In the case of Symphonic Line, carefully selected capacitors ensure that the signal is drawn as directly as possible from the source - almost directly from the Rhine, one might say.

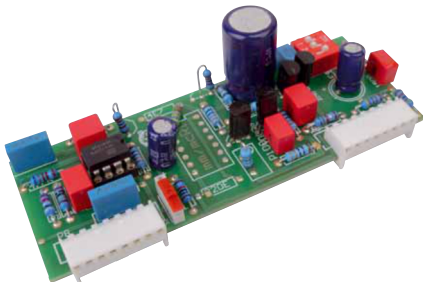
In the actual amplifier circuitry, things continue in a similarly sober manner. Inside the generously dimensioned enclosure there is only a single input - the output sockets have taken the place of a second input of the larger model MK 4, whose enclosure design is identical. On the main board sit, stacked, two input and output modules each. Clearly ...



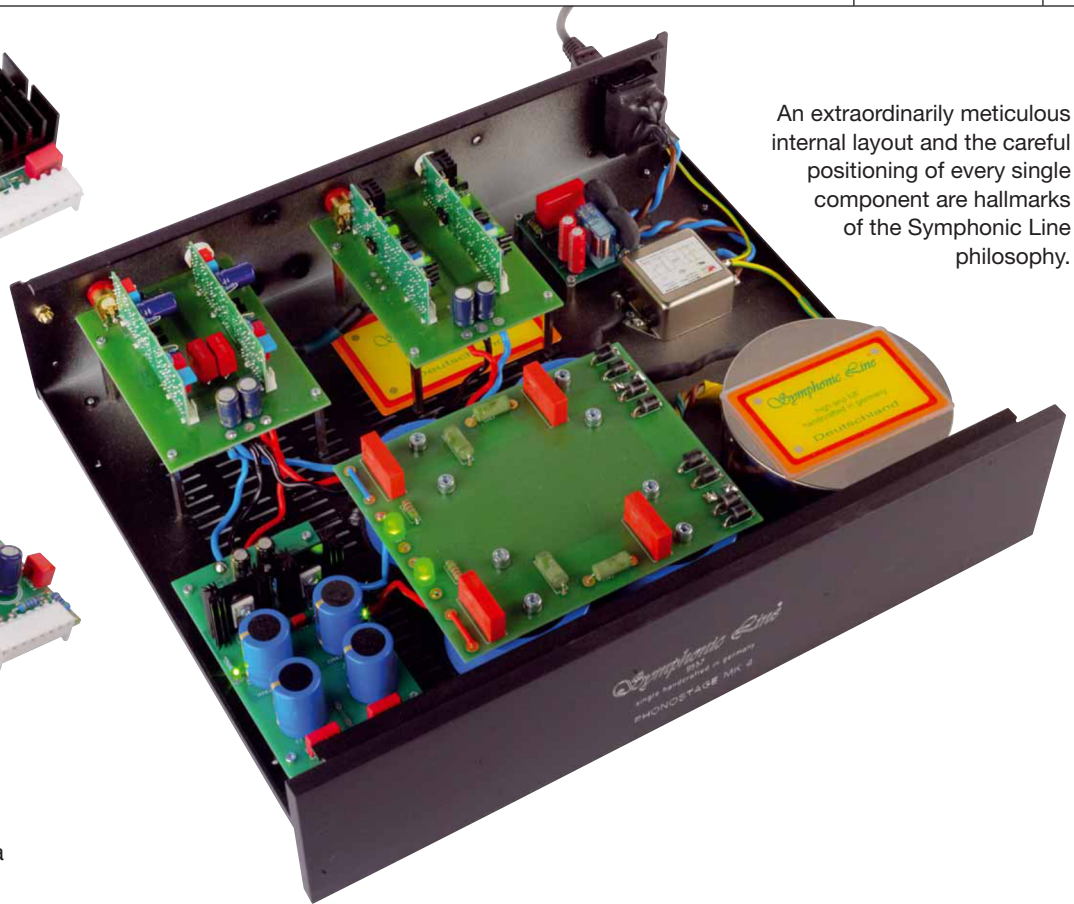
The generously oversized transformer is housed in a mumetall enclosure and is additionally damped by a gel pad.



The output stage is fully discrete in design and positioned directly at the output.



The actual phono stage is located directly at the input and can be adjusted in several parameters via a triple DIP switch.



An extraordinarily meticulous internal layout and the careful positioning of every single component are hallmarks of the Symphonic Line philosophy.

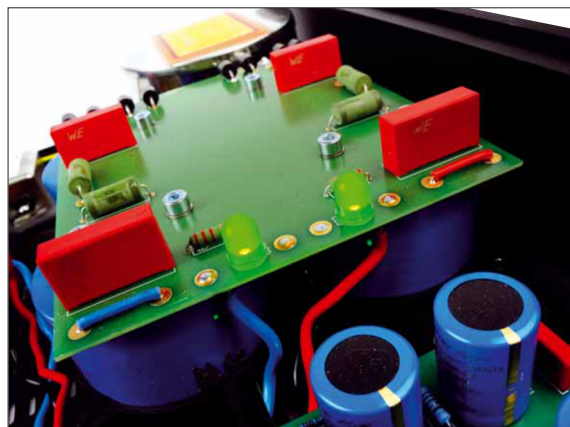
There is ample space for filtering, regulation and decoupling of the power supply - a aspect to which Rolf Gemein attaches the highest mechanical stability of the whole construction. The nearly oversized feet, featuring the distinctive Symphonic Line script, are bonded to a supporting wooden frame inside the chassis and constructed in multiple layers with gel filling to suppress resonances with lasting effectiveness.

Traditionally, the signal paths are kept as short as possible, the circuit operates in pure Class A, and the entire design is fully discrete - including a small "down-grading" compared to the

reference preamplifier, in which one would normally expect to see a board proudly populated with very small SMD transistors in IC form. Here, however, instead of the original IC seated in the phono stage socket, a component is employed that Rolf Gemein commissions exclusively from a specialist manufacturer for Symphonic Line. The designer places his trust solely in carefully selected parts - many of them chosen after years of listening evaluations. Less emphasis is placed on outward display. Anyone who searches for decorative showpieces on the rear panel or beneath the chassis will search in vain.



The custom-made smoothing capacitors produced specifically for Symphonic Line are no less impressive than the transformer.



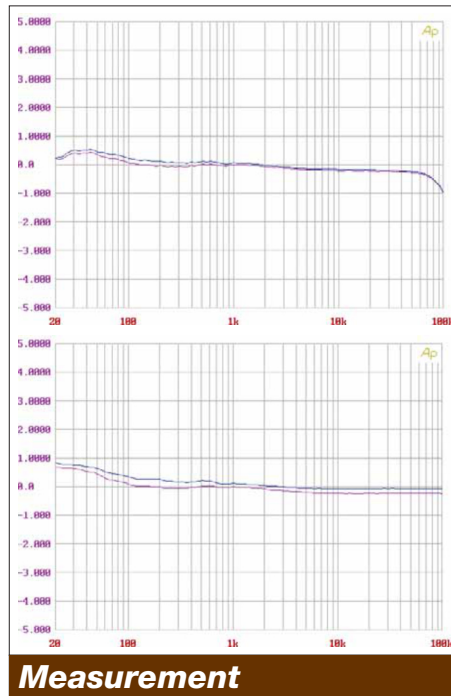
On the generously dimensioned power supply board, the components are allowed to "breathe freely."

Anyone searching for constant tinkering with the device will not find it here. The adjustment to MM or MC is made via DIP switches on the corresponding internal boards. If you want to alter capacitance or resistance values, you must open the unit.

Rolf Gemein would never place a sonically inferior switch in the signal path, just to spare the user a screwdriver. So you set it once, close the lid properly - carefully tightening the screws, because that matters - and then you devote yourself to music.

For the listening test deliberately avoided audiophile demo tracks" and instead reached straight for Beggars Banquet by The Rolling Stones. The needle drops - and what happens is what typically happens with Symphonic Line: the sound simply stands there. Charlie Watts' snare on "You Can't Always Get What You Want" is dry and full-bodied in the room, so tangible that one almost reflexively pulls back. The device presents the entire forward drive, the energy and inner propulsion of the band with an authority that once defined larger Röhr loudspeakers when driven hard - without that "compressed" box character some systems adopt.

But back to the phono stage: the MK 4 does not merely reproduce music. Somehow it finds a more immediate path, forging a spontaneous connection between listener and record. And it works. A change of scene: now for something more subtle. The dramatic dynamic swings in "Telegraph Road" by Dire Straits are a challenge



Measurement comments:

The frequency response measurements of both operating modes MM and MC differ only insignificantly. In MM there is a slightly elevated upper treble - academically, perhaps, something to measure but practically irrelevant.

In practice, the Symphonic Line is very flat across the audible range. At 0.03% distortion at 0.09% at 1 kHz (?), it demonstrates excellent performance values.

With a load resistance of 38 dB (A-weighted) and 66 dB (A-weighted), the unit is extremely quiet. With a power consumption of 23 watts, the Symphonic Line operates efficiently and without excess.

even for a high-end phono preamplifier. The Phonostage does not merely overcome them—it celebrates them. When the drums enter, there is no booming or blurring, only pure energy. At the same time, it places Mark Knopfler's guitar so vividly between the loudspeakers that one can almost see the strings vibrating—and therein lies the true feat: the system between recording and listener simply vanishes.

But can the "Ruhr Valley hammer" also speak softly? I place "Réflexions" by Hélène Grimaud on the platter. And behold: the MK 4 treats the recording with an almost tender precision. The decay of the strings, the space surrounding the grand piano—every nuance becomes distinctly audible. All of it unfolds against a background of the deepest black, once again proving how vital an over-dimensioned power supply truly is. No noise, no distraction. Only music.

What strikes me most is that the MK 4, in direct comparison to other preamplifiers, appears more coherent and more inwardly gathered. Where earlier there may have been emphasis, today there is balance. The high resolution never becomes analytical coldness; it never forces information upon you. It reveals details that were always present in the recording. And according to Rolf Gemein, this is precisely the goal: a device that ages like fine wine and, after years, still permits the discovery of new tonal landscapes. You may allow yourself that journey.

Hxos Sound and Hifi 3-2000

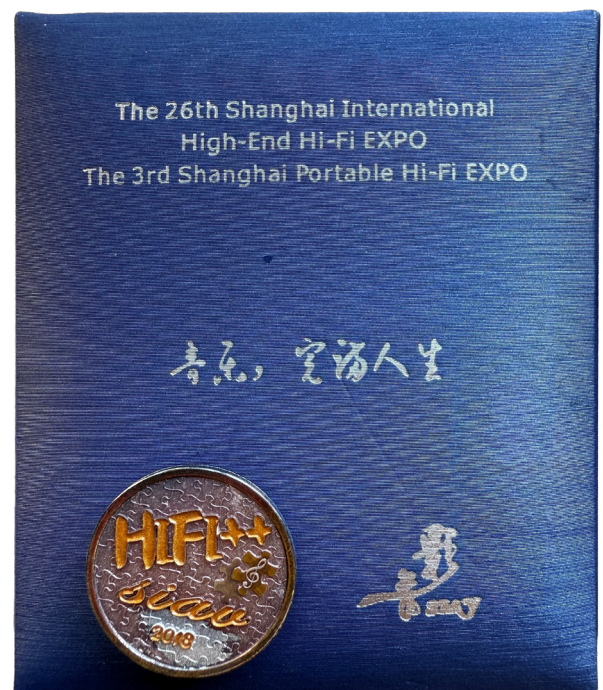

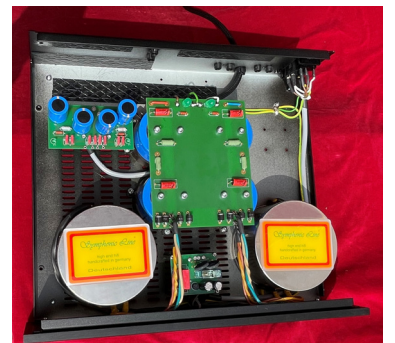

Premium fusion of a preamplifier/ power amplifier combination

The most powerful integrated amplifier from the Duisburg-based high-end manufacturer Symphonic Line has been upgraded once again: In the new "Edition" version, the flagship delivers even more power and sound culture - also thanks to the even more powerful power supply unit, which now also provides the power supply in a single external housing. We experienced the audiophile excellence this leads to in the world premiere test of the Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference Edition.

"Inside everything that is possible" - that is Rolf Gemein's short formula for the Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference Edition, which represents the quintessence and culmination of 45 years of analog integrated amplifier construction: For almost half a century, the co-founder of the German High End has been producing the very finest audio components with his Duisburg-based manufactory Symphonic Line and is particularly famous for his hand-built and personally tuned amplifiers. In addition to their sonic class, they guarantee sustainability, longevity and upgradeability: Joint amplifiers are built for analog eternity, are constantly being further developed and can still be updated even after many years thanks to their modular design.

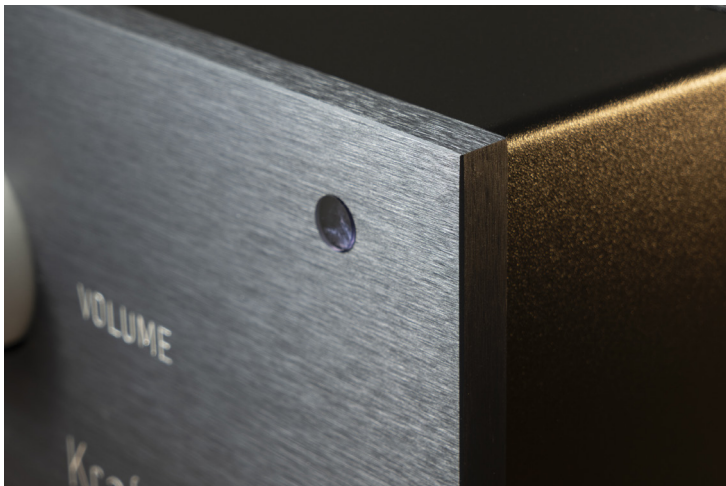
This also applies to the Kraftwerk: Symphonic Line's most powerful integrated amplifier has now reached its third generation and is available in two upgrade levels in addition to the standard version. According to Gemein, the brand new "Reference Edition" represents the maximum of what is possible and combines the power and quality of large preamplifiers and power amplifiers. We are excited!

Classic design with high recognition value

The Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference Edition doesn't look like an exception to the rule: Like all Symphonic Line amplifiers, the integrated amplifier flagship combines classic styling, a high-quality look and no-frills design with a high recognition value. We have already seen the RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S and the RG 14 Edition MK 5 S - and this transistor amplifier is no different: Measuring 13 by 45 by 42 centimeters, this powerhouse is an impressive representative of established hi-fi component dimensions. The highly robust, two millimetre thick, powder-coated sheet steel body is fronted by a centimetre-thick front panel made of finely brushed and elegantly anodized aluminum. In our test model, it is black, alter-

natively it is available in silver, and the amplifier can also be produced in chrome on request. Either way: The company logo is engraved on the front in curved letters - and then the model name and the function names of the controls are milled in straight lines.

Maximum quality maxim

The Kraftwerk has three of these: the Symphonic Line-typical and expensive satin-finished metal knobs with a distinctive bevel and engraved dot that provides orientation with regard to the current setting. The arrangement of the knobs is the first time the luxury powerhouse has shown its special status: while they are usually arranged in a row on the Symphonic Line, here they form a triangle. This doesn't change their haptic quality: when operating them, we first experience the pleasant coolness and the beautiful weightiness of the solid metal knobs - and then the smooth movement of the volume dial and the clean detent of the two rotary selector switches. When switched on, there is also the reassuring clicking of relays: the signal paths and speaker outputs are enabled and disabled mechanically and therefore absolutely clean. The excellent "Blue Velvet" potentiometer from the highly acclaimed specialist Alps is used for volume control - as with all components of this amplifier, the maxim of maximum quality applies here.

The all-metal, satin-finished control knobs contribute to the characteristic design with their striking bevel and milled orientation point. The two rotary selector switches and the volume control have a pleasant tactile feel and are easy to operate with excellent detent and smooth movement. For once, the controls on this integrated amplifier flagship are not arranged in a row, but in a triangle.

A wide range of connections with an excellent phono module

This rotary potentiometer is motorized. In combination with the infrared eye, which is inserted into the front panel, this allows the volume to be changed even from a distance. Exclusively for the Edition version of the amplifier, Symphonic Line supplies an elegant, ultra-massive metal remote control in brushed anodized aluminium, which is worthy of the premium quality of the amplifier. Source selection, on the other hand, is only possible on the amplifier itself. This is where the Kraftwerk shines with its extensive range of connections. The input section scores points with four line inputs, two tape loops for the analog integration of recording devices including a rear tape control/monitor function and a phono input for turntables with a moving magnet or moving coil



Symphonic Line supplies a system remote control with the amplifier for adjusting the volume from a distance. For the Reference Edition version, it is realized in a high-quality metal housing. It is presented in brushed and anodized aluminium to match the amplifier. Thanks to the thick material, this remote control weighs almost 700 grams.

system. The excellent phono module cards, which amplify the incoming turntable signal behind these sockets and equalize it according to the RIAA characteristic curve, allow you to switch to the appropriate amplification for MM or MC and also to adjust the capacitance and impedance values. This makes the Kraftwerk also interesting for demanding vinylists - and thus offers everything that distinguishes a classic analog integrated amplifier.

Superb sockets and terminals including headphone output

This completeness also applies to the outputs. In addition to the two recording outs of the tape loops already mentioned, the amp offers two pre outs. One of these can be used to split the amplifier into preamp and power amp - if you don't want to use the Kraftwerk as an integrated amplifier. Normally, however, the preamp and power amp are connected with external jumper cables. This is done with connectors, which are only used in the Edition version with the Symphonic Line Reference cable and expensive RCA plugs from WBT. The excellent RCA sockets for the inputs and outputs and the superb speaker terminals also come from the renowned Essen-based connector specialist. They are all gold-plated using the PVD plasma process and therefore have a very smooth surface with a maximized contact area. For the speaker connection, the amplifier provides four terminals for a pair of transducers. Alternatively, the rear panel offers a headphone output in the form of a large jack socket. This means that the Kraftwerk can also be used for private music enjoyment.

Modular design, shortest signal paths, personal optimization

Within the amplifier, the maximum claim to material and manufacturing quality continues. The service and modernization-friendly modular design is immediately apparent: The preamplifier is realized with several plug-in cards, the power amplifier in a strictly separated double mono design. Rolf Gemein has paid attention to the shortest possible signal paths, which are also of the highest quality. The circuit boards are equipped with particularly strong conductor tracks, which are copper-plated to 130 micrometers and gold-plated at key points. The components and connections are connected via cables, which Symphonic Line also manufactures as dedicated audio signal and speaker cables. A special cable with low dielectric properties is used for the RCA sockets to preserve the audio quality of the sensitive signals. In addition, various components and housing parts are coated with bitumen plates and selectively applied C37 lacquer. Rolf Gemein uses this to perform a "resonance pattern tuning": a final, detailed optimization of each individual amplifier to eliminate all detrimental vibration and resonance tendencies until the amplifier plays in perfect harmony.

Pre- and power amplifier in powerful Class A

Now to the amplifier circuitry: The Kraftwerk amplifies with pure transistor technology in a completely discrete design. The preamp stage is in pure Class A. The transistors are operated in such a way that they work in their linear characteristic range, thus amplifying the music signal without deforming its shape. The power amplifier of



A wide range of connections: The Kraftwerk offers four designated line inputs, two tape loops - and a phono input for vinylists, which can be configured for MM or MC. The corresponding ground terminal prevents the creation of a ground loop. The corresponding ground wire of the cable coming from the turntable is connected to this screw terminal. The amplifier also scores points on the output side: In addition to the two unregulated line outputs of the tape loops, there are two regulated pre outs. One of these is normally connected to the Main In, in which case the Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference Edition acts as an integrated amplifier as intended. Without these bridges, the preamp or power amp can be used separately. The three multi-pin sockets labeled "AC" and "DC" are used to connect the external power supply. The black cover visible to the left already indicates this: The Kraftwerk can still be expanded on the connection side. A balanced input or output in the form of two XLR sockets can be implemented here on request.



Under the hood, the amplifier shines with its modular design, which facilitates servicing and upgrades, and the clean dual-mono design of the power amplifier. Its power transistors are screwed directly to the underside of the large Kührippen bodies. The center section with the two blue capacitor rows is part of the otherwise outsourced power supply.

the Kraftwerk now corresponds to the circuitry of the Kraft 300, a legendary and excellent Class A power amplifier with a double mono design that impressed us in the test with the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3. This power amplifier concept also provides pure and ample power in the Kraftwerk - especially in the Edition version: Here, four complementary pairs of transistors per channel now operate in a push-pull circuit and thus provide an output of a full 350 (!) watts into four ohms - per channel. At higher volumes, the power amplifier smoothly transitions from Class A to Class AB operation - for pure Class A operation, you would need cabinet-sized heat sinks.

External power supply, for the first time in a cabinet

The Kraftwerk consists of two components: The actual amplifier includes an external power supply. It is so large that it was housed in two external enclosures in the standard and reference versions of the amplifier. In the new "Reference Edition" of the Kraftwerk, however, it is now integrated into a single power supply body for the first time. It now has almost the same impressive dimensions as the amplifier section. There is a reason for this fundamentally large dimensioning: more decisive than the wattage of the amplifier is the power and quality of its power supply. It must meet the following requirements: high current delivery capacity in a short time - and simultaneously for the entire audible frequency range. This fast and even distribution of energy is decisive for the audible and tangible physical force with which the amplifier causes the loudspeakers to convert the electrical energy into air movement. It is therefore sometimes surprising that many an amplifier with an awe-inspiring wattage rating is unable to deliver this potential power noticeably during operation.

Special transformers and capacitor cascade for even energy distribution

In the "Reference Edition" version of the Kraftwerk, the external power supply has therefore been given a further boost in power and quality: The three transformers for the preamplifier and the two power amplifiers can deliver an opulent apparent power of up to 1,400 volt-amperes. A further improved version of the extremely expensive mu-metal transformers is used here. Their cores are annealed several times and the many different windings are painstakingly made by hand in order to achieve an even distribution of energy right up to the high frequencies. The screening and smoothing capacitors, in turn, have a huge capacity of 480,000 microfarads. Here, contacted

capacitors specially manufactured for Symphonic Line operate in a cascade of capacitors graduated by ear - here too in favor of fast and even energy distribution. Because a complete outsourcing of the power supply proved to be disadvantageous due to the long cable runs, part of the filtering section is housed in the amplifier. Three cables run from the external power supply unit to the amplifier, one of which supplies direct current and two alternating current.

The Symphonic Line Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference Edition in practice

Let's take the Kraftwerk into the listening room. This is a bit of a weight training exercise, because the amplifier alone weighs a whopping 16 kilos and the external power supply unit weighs another opulent 26 kilos - no wonder given the massive design and the large components used here. Symphonic line amplifiers reward you for giving them time to warm up. This is also the case with the Kraftwerk. We connect it to the Dali Epikore 7, set up and align the speakers and curiously get a first listening impression: it already sounds pretty good, we can already hear the Symphonic Line-typical coherence that we have come to know and love in other amplifiers from the Duisburg manufacturer. At the same time, we are only just in the low room volume range. Nevertheless, everything is already there, right down to the bass - and we can perceive the power and energy that this amplifier has.

Phenomenal resolution and accuracy

But there's more: with every subsequent listening session, the reproduction sounds freer and more open, more vivid and spatial, livelier and more dynamic. After an hour or so, the Kraftwerk has developed its sound potential - and that is simply magnificent. To warm up the amplifier and align the speakers, we chose Eva Cassidy's legendary live recording of her performance at the Blues Alley club and were immediately fascinated by the opener "Blue Skies": Eva Cassidy counts off the song, snaps the tempo with her fingers - and just these three seconds are enough for the Kraftwerk to transport us to the famous



When opened, you can see why this power supply unit weighs 26 kilos: Apart from the robust housing, the three large mu-metal transformers alone add plenty of weight. Their slightly offset arrangement is intentional and, according to Rolf Gemein, has just as much influence on the sound as the geometry of the circuit design. The Symphonic Line boss also attaches special adhesive pads to the transformers to optimize the sound and uses C37 lacquer in selected areas for the final "resonance pattern tuning", which he personally performs on each amplifier.

Washington club: Thanks to the phenomenal resolution and accuracy, we can hear the room reflections caused by the snapping, but also already the background noise that characterizes every room - and even the almost silent audience is already perceptible with its presence. We know the recording well - but we have never heard the beginning of a concert with such detail and immediacy.

The magic of the piano's sound

The amazement continues with the opening piano part: every keystroke by Lenny Williams has a wonderful precision and presence, as if we were sitting right next to the piano and could look at Williams' fingers. The melody notes of the right hand literally sparkle, and in combination with the chords of the left hand this leads to the magic of the piano's sound: thanks to the polychoral nature of each note, numerous strings are already vibrating here, while the others are also excited by the soundboard and piano case - and so up to 230 strings vibrate with even a briefly sustained chord, triggering a fascinating shimmering and floating of the multitude of tones and overtones. To make this audible, the reproduction must be highly transparent and finely resolved - and the Kraftwerk achieves this perfectly. Now drummer Raice McLeod briefly hits the hi-hat on two and four, and this is enough for us to locate him at the back and sound out the depth of the stage in this club.

Absolute coherence

The Kraftwerk also makes it easy for us to experience the imagined spatiality of this recording afterwards: Using the entire band results in a great three-dimensional imaging. The depth of the stage, which is quite small in reality, is also superb: the drums at the back, the piano on the left, the bass on the half-right and front woman Eva Cassidy right in front of us. When the band plays together, we enjoy this feeling of absolute coherence even more now that the amplifier is warm: Cassidy's voice and all the instruments are sung and played to the point - and the



The Kraftwerk offers excellent pole terminals from WBT's PVD PlasmaProtect series. They can be used to connect a pair of speakers. This is achieved using pre-assembled cables with banana plugs or cable lugs. However, the terminals have no receptacles for bare wires, which makes connecting the bare wire bundles somewhat more difficult. For fans of headphone playback, the amplifier has an alternative phones out in the form of a large jack plug socket.

Kraftwerk also delivers their respective frequency ranges at the same time and to the point, starting with the ride cymbal strikes that extend far into the super high frequencies down to the deep tones of the bass guitar. This amplifier is incredibly fast! The simultaneity and promptness mean that even at low levels we perceive the reproduction as present, complete and powerful: It's all there.

Great dynamics, incredible pressure

This promptness and speed of the Kraftwerk also ensures that the music sounds wonderfully fresh and vital and that the playback develops great dynamics. The opening snap of the fingers already made us sit up and take notice, as did the touch of the piano keys - but as "Blue Skies" progresses, it is of course the drums in particular that impress with their percussiveness: in terms of fine dynamics, it is the figures on the metal rim and on the bell of the ride cymbal that are played with a beautiful gradation of intensity. In terms of coarse dynamics, it's the snare hits that are repeatedly thrown in that impress us with their lack of attack. The succinctly kicked bass drum also has a wonderful punch. We now turn the am-

plifier up further until we reach the fullest possible level. The volume knob is still only at ten o'clock! Now this amplifier delivers a power, a punch and a pressure that can be physically felt on the body that we have never heard before from an integrated amplifier.

Absolutely tidy and contoured

Our "Morph The Cat" test reflex kicks in immediately: This number by Donald Fagen starts with a low note from bassist Freddie Washington, which then goes all the way down to the abysmal D of his five-string, as well as a bass drum and cymbal hit from drummer Keith Carlock, who then plays a cool beat on his drums. This seamless, highly dynamic and explosive introduction is especially fun with really big amplifier ensembles and loudspeakers. The Kraftwerk first leaves us in disbelief and then brings a grin to our faces. The deep and ultra-voluminous bass remains absolutely tidy and contoured even at brute levels, the bass drum, which massages our stomachs with plenty of gusto, and the snare, which makes us wince with its blows, are dry and precise - and the entire densely composed music, in which fourteen singers and instrumentalists participate, remains completely transparent and audible down to the subtleties of the muted, barely audible accompanying guitar.

Power, control and sound culture of a pre/power amp combination

The Kraftwerk makes all of this clearly and cleanly audible with its sound culture, even at this level. We only know this power and control, this calmness and serene mightiness from large pre/power amp combinations! Wow! The Kraftwerk really lives up to its name. With this broadband and prompt power, the amplifier drives even difficult loudspeakers - such as the compact Radiant Acoustics Clarity 6.2, which only really show their full class with a powerful and perfectly controlled drive. This is not about reproduction at a high level, but about listening at a comfortable volume. So far, we have always found the bass of these speakers, which we have already used with various amplifiers, to be a little too pronounced. With the Kraftwerk behind us, however, the balance is just right. The small loudspeaker now amazes in the bass range with a sovereignty and definition that one would attribute to a large sound transducer. This amplifier and loudspeaker pairing makes an excellent combination.

Immense imaging power

Now we switch from CD to phono playback. To do this, we connect our Transrotor Dark Star. The turntable is initially equipped with the Uccello MM cartridge. Accordingly, we set the switches on the phono modules in the Kraftwerk cabinet to MM amplification, 47 kilohms termination resistance and the termination capacitance of 150 picofarads recommended by Symphonic Line. This is how we hear the duet "Toi! Vous! / Oui, C'est Moi! - N'est-ce Plus Ma Main" with Anna Netrebko and Rolando Villazón. A wonderful duet - and a wonderful reproduction: here, too, the Kraftwerk demonstrates its immense performance power. We have already mentioned the spatiality, but the plasticity with which the amplifier places the musicians on stage has so far been criminally

overlooked. The Kraftwerk also shines in this discipline: the presence and presence with which we perceive Netrebko as Manon and Villazón as Des Grieux on the imagined stage is excellent.

Grand opera in phono mode

But now we are used to and "spoiled" by MC, so we convert the turntable to the Goldring Ethos. We set the amplification on the phono boards of the Kraftwerk to MC and follow Rolf Gemein's recommendation to set the terminating resistor to 1,000 ohms instead of the 100 ohms that are actually more usual for this system. And the sun rises immediately: With its excellent phono module, the Kraftwerk delivers that magical openness, airiness, spaciousness and ultra-fine resolution for which we love MC systems. We can now hear the smallest breaths, the softest vibratos all the more easily and experience even more vividly the refined art of seduction of the voices that Netrebko and Villazón use to confess their love for each other as Manon and Des Grieux. The world stars achieve this with such intimacy and intensity that we sit spellbound on the sofa and revel in it. This is grand opera!

Orchestral power

And this gala also extends to the orchestra: we experience the Staatskapelle Dresden as a wonderfully broad and deep orchestra. We can hear the individual instrumental groups and soloists with ease, from the first violinists' bowing to the distant, quiet bells warning us to leave, delicately rung by the percussionist far in the background. Conductor Nicola Luisotti conducts the Staatskapelle Dresden with clever dynamic shaping, effectively heightening the emotionality of this love duet - and the Kraftwerk delivers these orchestral dynamics with wonderful effectiveness. Here, too, we experience the penetrating power and presence of the large-scale musical ensemble even at low level settings. The Kraftwerk also

flexes its muscles via the headphone output: even our electrostatic MrSpeakers Aeon Flow Closed, which has a low impedance of 13 ohms and a rather low efficiency of 92 decibels, is driven by the amplifier effortlessly and with a cultivated sound.

Conclusion

The new "Edition" version of the Symphonic Line Kraftwerk MK 3 Reference offers a breathtaking and astonishing performance: the most powerful integrated amplifier from the Duisburg-based high-end manufacturer delivers a combination of power, control and sound culture in this maximum configuration that we are only familiar with from large-scale pre/power amplifier combinations. This is thanks to the fast, simultaneous current delivery capability across the entire frequency range. Even at low levels, it leads to a stupendous coherence and completeness of the music, to an outstanding presence of voices and instruments - and leaves nothing to be desired in terms of power and reserves at high levels.

In addition to the amplifier, whose output stage corresponds to the Kraft 300 Class A power amplifier, this is due in particular to the outsourced power supply unit, which is even more powerful in the "Edition" version. The Kraftwerk shines in the quiet as well as in the loud with brilliant dynamics, wonderful clarity, noticeable energy and powerful presentation magic. With this audiophile excellence, the Edition version is the noble fusion of an (otherwise much more expensive) pre/power amplifier combination.

The Pure Side of Power

A Class A power amplifier with rich performance? This audiophile concept was revolutionary forty years ago. With the brand new Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3, Symphonic Line proves that it is still a royal road to outstanding sound: If you didn't already know that Kraft means "power" in German, this stereo power amplifier proves it with the latest technology and its acoustic excellence in lite magazine's world premiere test.

Rolf Gemein? Upon hearing this name, Hi-Fi connoisseurs will immediately think of Symphonic Line: The co-founder of German High End has been manufacturing fine audio components with his Duisburg-based manufactory for over forty years and is particularly famous for his handmade, personally tuned amplifiers. At the same time, Gemein attaches great importance to durability and upgradeability: All models in the portfolio are constantly being redeveloped and can still be updated even many years later. The Kraft holds a special place in this context: Its concept goes back to a legendary power amplifier that Gemein helped develop four decades ago - at his previous company, Vernissage. Symphonic Line now celebrates the fortieth birthday of this transistor amplifier with the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 - and this freshly perfected anniversary power amplifier celebrates its world premiere in lite magazine.

Amplifier ancestor: The Vernissage Kraft 100

Revolutionary, legendary - what exactly justifies these big words for the Vernissage Kraft 100, as the original power amplifier was once called? Before we get into that, there are two fundamental things to know. One: Sound quality depends on the quiescent current. A power amplifier gains fine detail with higher quiescent current and gains better control over the connected loudspeakers. The high quiescent current means that the transistor is always set to conduct and amplify the music signal in its linear operating range. This ensures pristine sound and



The housing of the power amplifier is made of solid aluminum, which is finely brushed and cleanly anodized - with one exception: Inside, the bottom of the amplifier has been left untreated and rough. According to Symphonic Line founder Rolf Gemein, this fine unevenness provides resistance to eddy current influences that are harmful to sound.

minimizes distortion. That is what makes Class A the ideal operating mode. This realization was not new when Rolf Gemein designed the Kraft 100: There were already Class A power amplifiers like the Pioneer M-22 or the Mark Levinson ML-2. But they all had the same weak point: Their rated power was too low. That meant they were not able to adequately drive the watt-hungry speakers. There is a reason for this limited power: The Class A amplifier circuit - so exquisite in terms of sound - has a miserable efficiency.

Immense effort, imposing appearance

Due to the constantly high quiescent current that flows even when no music signal is amplified, a Class A amp converts a considerable part of the input energy into heat rather than watts. Higher power output thus became the main challenge. That's why the Kraft 100 was revolutionary at the time - for two reasons: One was that it was the first German Class A power amplifier ever. The other is that it succeeded in outdoing its legendary rivals in sound-critical performance. An immense amount of effort was put into this - and it is still part of the concept to which the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 is also committed today. It starts with the housing: With its imposing dimensions of 60 by 25 by 32 centimeters, it already visually portrays the idea of power. This body is made entirely of solid aluminum. The front panel has a wall thickness of ten millimeters. The no-frills design of the angular cuboid underscores this impressive appearance.

Mechanical silence, maximum cooling

This housing contributes to the whopping weight of around 45 kilograms - and this massiveness is the basis for another characteristic of the power amplifier: It is designed for maximum mechanical quietness. This avoidance of vibrations pays off acoustically during quiet playback. The black anodization of the finely brushed aluminum only serves to make the power amplifier even



The side heatsink cooling fins ensure fast heat dissipation. This is indispensable especially for a Class A amplifier, which, by principle, runs at a higher temperature. Here, Symphonic Line relies on expensive fin heatsinks with a first-class cooling rating.

more imposing. Alternatively, it also comes in silver and, at extra cost, even in gleaming chrome, which, however, Rolf Gemein does not prefer for tonal reasons. Either way: The body is braced on both sides with large, ribbed areas. Expensive special heat sinks with a first-class cooling rating of 0.1 instead of the usual 0.5 are used here. They enable highly effective heat dissipation. This is essential for a Class A power amplifier with high power potential. This already characterized the primordial Kraft. Even on the inside, the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 follows the concept and principles of its ancestor amp.

Consistent double-mono design

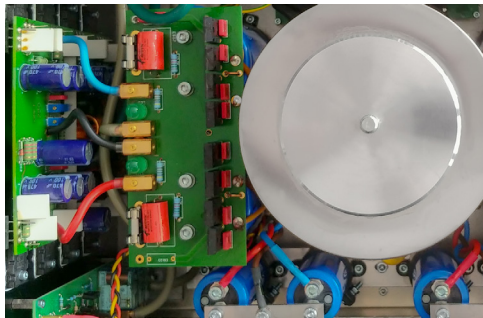
For example, this stereo power amplifier has always been built in a double-mono design and actually houses two mono blocks in one case. So, the left and right channels are amplified completely independently of each other. This eliminates any crosstalk or mutual influence. They are driven with absolutely stringent separation in the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3. Thus, each mono block has its own power supply and even its own mains connection. The input power supply is the basis for the output power, sound, silence, and dynamics of any amplifier. Therefore, it must offer high delivery efficiency so that the transistors can be powered strongly even during signal peaks and can do their amplification job just as strongly. This purpose is served by two hulking toroidal transformers in the power amplifier, solving the mystery of why this amp weighs in at nearly a hundredweight. Compared to the regular Kraft 300 MK 3, our Anniversary Edition uses even more powerful transformers: Instead of 1,400 volt-amperes, they can deliver 1,600 volt-amperes.



On the back, the double-mono design of the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 becomes apparent: The case houses two completely independent mono blocks which, consistent with the model's design, each have their own power supply and even their own mains connection. The yellow Symphonic Line sticky pad is part of the sound optimization by Rolf Gemein.

Elaborate power supply

These extremely expensive, intricately hand-wound transformers are also designed in the Anniversary Edition as specially burned-in Mu-metal transformers: They have a nickel-iron cladding that provides excellent shielding. Thus, the transformers do not emit radiation that would cause humming or buzzing in the audio circuit. However, capacitors are also critical to power supply's ability to deliver. Voltage smoothing and energy storage are provided by electrolytic capacitors of imposing dimensions, specially manufactured for Symphonic Line, with a total capacity of 300,000 microfarads. Again, a lot has gone into this: A section of smaller electrolytic capacitors acts as a buffer for the main, coffee-cup-sized capacitors. Symphonic Line uses multi-contacted and thus loss-minimized versions with special dielectric material. The individual electrolytic capacitors are connected via metal rails, which improves energy dissipation. On the bottom side, the capacitors are fixed in separate sockets. Despite all this separation, the overall design of the power amplifier is surprisingly compact. According to Gemein, the compact design and short paths allow even energy distribution – and are therefore also part of the Kraft concept.



A look under the hood: Here we see the upper of the two super-imposed Mu-metal transformers. Extra-potent versions come into play for the Anniversary Edition: Each of these transformers is capable of delivering 800 volt-amps – adding up to a whopping 1,600 volt-amps. Beneath them, you can see the smaller electrolytic capacitors, which serve as a buffer for the large electrolytic capacitors of the power supply. Their connection via metal rails ensures better energy dissipation. Otherwise, Symphonic Line uses extremely high-quality conductor material for the connection, which is also used in the maker's signal cables.

Compact design for short signal paths

Small distances are especially crucial for audio circuitry: Short signal paths preserve the sound quality and fine resolution that have been produced with so much effort and material input, while these acoustic merits get washed out over long conductor distances. That's why Gemein has spent decades working on the compact design and has now achieved masterful minimization of circuit board size – despite the completely discrete circuit design, which uses individual components instead of integrated circuits. As always, only the best, select components are used. But the selection is even stricter in this Anniversary Edition of the power amplifier. The credo to use Choice Components applies equally to the connections: For the speaker connection, nextgen pole terminals from WBT are installed and the unbalanced RCA inputs also come from the Essen-based specialist. The Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 furthermore offers an optional balanced input. However, Gemein favors the RCA connection: Unlike the XLR connection, it has been constantly developed further and thus improved in terms of sound. Gemein attests to its superiority especially in the ultra-high range.

Class A operation up to 30 watts

Let's move on to the actual amplifier circuit: It is designed for Class A operation. In other words, the transistors are set to act in their linear range and are always conductive. This means that the signal is preserved in its original form, and the transfer distortions that are typical problems of push-pull amplifiers are minimized. This purity

comes at the price of low gain and high heat loss. That's why the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3, which delivers a sine wave output of 300 watts in keeping with its name, does not operate completely in Class A mode. For that, you would need fridge-sized heatsinks. The pure Class A range is therefore still set to a full 30 watts, after which it smoothly transitions to Class AB operation. Amplification is performed by four driver transistors and six NPN/PNP transistor pairs per channel. The components used here are the original Toshiba power transistors that already contributed to the top sound of the RG14 Edition MK5 S and RG 10 MK 5 Reference HD Master S integrated amplifiers we previously tested.

Manufacture with individual fine tuning

An amplifier section that delivers a total of 600 watts, plus a power supply that provides 1,600 volt-amps at a capacity of 300,000 microfarads – makes the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 a challenge for any circuit breaker. That's why Symphonic Line has given the power amplifier a power-on delay, which gently brings the amplifier into the operating state. The only thing left is the fine-tuning: This represents the final step of manufacturing by hand. This individual tuning is also a part of the Kraft concept and of Symphonic Line's general manufacturing philosophy. Rolf Gemein does this tuning personally – among other things using special adhesive pads and spot-applied C37 lacquer. According to Gemein, this

tuning serves to optimize spatiality as well as energy density and promotes a natural sound. Rolf Gemein does the fine-tuning by ear – until he is satisfied that the amplifier plays optimally and harmoniously. Sometimes this tuning takes several days.

The Symphonic Line Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 in practice

Let's finally heave the power amplifier into the listening room. Here, we get it to play with the matching preamp Symphonic Line RG 2 MK 5 Reference Edition HD S. The sound reproduction is done by the Acapella Harlekin 2. The player is the SACD player Oppo UDP-203. Before getting down to listening, you are supposed to give the power amplifier and the entire sound chain a warm-up and play-in period. An hour with at least five minutes of music signal is the recommendation; then the spatiality unfolds to its fullest. We let Ulita Knaus' beautiful version of the Gerry Rafferty classic "Baker Street" run for the warm-up, which we listen in on a little now and then – and yes, this warm-up hour is time well invested, because now the Kraft unfolds its full sound culture. For the test, we listen to "Baker Street" from the beginning – and it takes exactly one second, and we are already spellbound in our seats on the sofa. And not even a single note of music has played yet...

Magnificent presence

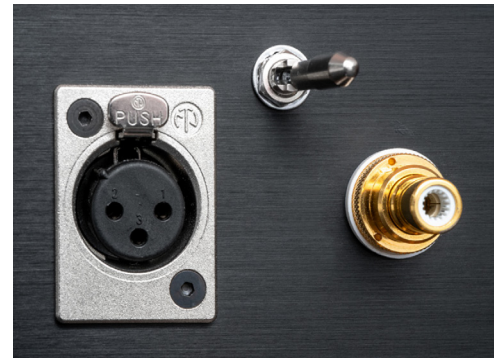
...However, Ulita Knaus inhaled softly to start singing – and already this small sound places the singer in our listening space with magnificent presence. Incredible! This physicality now becomes a total experience when her voice comes in: Knaus opens the song with an onomatopoeic sequence of notes, her voice with a beguiling fullness, warmth and softness, and at the latest with the beautiful vibrato at the end of this phrase she has us wrapped around her finger. The intense presence we experience is due to the immense clarity and superb resolving power of the reproduction. Knaus' voice is embedded in an artificial reverb, we hear with ease the reflections of this imaginary space – and thus have already succumbed to the illusionary power of the reproduction. This is intensified by the addition of the backing group: First the piano enters, slightly to the left behind Knaus, then the bass positioned to the right comes in, as do the drums set up in the back.

Immersive experience

With the backing group's addition, the space we had already perceived from the voice is now filled by the instruments. It is an absolutely immersive experience, where the height and width of the imaginary stage as well as the depth positioning are excellent. The spatiality of this reproduction makes us forget the real confines of our room. The instruments can develop completely freely. This is particularly impressive with the piano. The power amplifier offers an unbalanced input as a standard feature, which is realized with first-class RCA jacks from WBT. If desired, a balanced XLR input can also be installed. A toggle switch with fuse is then used for switching: Only when you first pull the head out a little can the switch be flipped.

Stupendous clarity and accuracy

Of course, this presence also results from a perfect dynamic representation. The reproduction only has a convincing physicality if a perfect gradation from the softest to the loudest sound or noise is achieved in the fine as well as in the coarse – and this quickly and precisely. Once again, the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 performs magnificently: The sound culture is joined by a percussion culture. This fidelity to the dynamics and impulse has already placed the piano as a physical instrument in our room, but it is even more impressive in the drums: Heinz Lichius plays in a completely song-serving, restrained manner, with the occasional touch to a cymbal, then a discreet brushing over the snare – and we hear with stupendous clarity and accuracy how the bristles of the brushes touch the dented cymbal metal and hit the plastic head of the snare. What phenomenal materiality! Thus with the drums, too, we experience an almost physically palpable presence with us.

Power and lightness down to the bass

The same goes for the bass: Gerold Donker plays mostly long sustained tones, which the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 puts into the room down into the lowest registers with all its power and carrying force and at the same time with a wonderful lightness and relaxedness. Nevertheless, the bass remains absolutely cleanly separated from the piano's lower registers; nothing blurs or overlaps. Here the clarity inherent in the total reproduction of all instruments comes to perfection. The power amplifier maintains this composure even at high volumes: At the richest levels, the physical experience intensifies, but the perfect purity and transparency of the reproduction, the infinite calm and serenity of this power amplifier, remains intact. It is simply marvelous – especially when you consider that the Acapella Harlequin 2, as the speakers, also demand plenty of power here. The Harlequin 2 revealed the limits of our 250 watt per channel Hegel H360 integrated amplifier.



The power amplifier is equipped with excellent nextgen pole terminals from WBT. They allow you to connect one or two pairs of speakers. The pole terminals accept assembled cables with banana plugs or cable lugs, but have no receptacles for bare stranded wire.

Audiophile driver

The Kraft 300, on the other hand, proves to be an audiophile booster even at the richest levels - and even with really demanding tracks. This applies, for example, to "Arabian Desert Groove", where drum grandmaster Charlie Antolini and percussion luminary Nippy Noya ignite a veritable fireworks display of percussions over top of Wolfgang Schmid's murderously deep bass: Every drum, cymbal and bell has excellent dynamics and precision, making the reproduction wonderfully fresh and vital - and the explosive strikes make us flinch several times. The power amplifier, on the other hand, is a sea of tranquility - because it has power and reserves and plays precisely to the point thanks to its fast response. All this also makes classical music playback an enrapturing event. We choose Wagner's prelude to "The Valkyrie", recorded by the Bavarian State Orchestra - and promptly find ourselves sitting in Munich's National Theater for this live recording, which has captured the hall atmosphere as well as the sounds of the orchestra musicians. We have never experienced it this real before!

Perfect depth positioning

Our amazement extends equally to the imaging of the instruments: The nervous tremolo of the violins and violas has an outstanding accuracy in the bowing, and the perfectly rendered rapid rise and fall of the volume vividly conveys the intended unease, especially as the cellos and basses contribute a somber minor motif with stabbing, choppy staccato notes. We literally feel the impending doom, and are involuntarily startled when, at the climax, the kettledrums and trumpets suddenly drive into our bodies. What a performance! The vividness and three-dimensionality of the reproduction let us hear a perfectly staged sound body in which each instrument can be clearly located. The powerful amplifier shines doubly as a highly sensitive reproduction instrument: Beyond the music subtleties, it also renders the smallest changes in the sound chain - right down to the decoupling on the underside of the mains filter strip. Thus, the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 puts a grin on our faces and treats us to a glamorous evening at the opera.

In combination with a suitable preamplifier, the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3 delivers up to 300 watts of power - and thus effortlessly drives even demanding speakers.

Conclusion

Symphonic Line brings the Kraft concept magnificently into the present with the new Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3: This stereo power amplifier combines Class A with power in a consistent dual-mono design - achieving world-class reproduction. The power amplifier has immense power and ample reserves, offers perfect purity, clarity and transparency, triumphs with accuracy, precision and absolutely perfect timing, delivers outstandingly vivid and three-dimensional imaging, and excels with breathtaking dynamics. The power amplifier accomplishes all this with wonderful calm, composure, and ease. This exquisite acoustic excellence results in fully relaxed, harmonious, perfected musical enjoyment. Thus, with the Kraft 300 Class A Anniversary Edition MK 3, we experience the pure side of power.
